

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- President Anwar Sadat has declined an offer of an honorary degree from the Ben Gurion University of the Negev in Beersheba. But he had agreed to address the university May 26 when he and Premier Menachem Begin will fly to Beersheba in Sadat's plane.

BIENNA (WNS) -- Leftist demonstrators clashed with a group of neo - Nazis from Europe and the United States, in Nazi uniforms, in Hitler's hometown of Braunau April 21 where the Nazis had gathered to mark Hitler's 90th birthday.

BONN (WNS) -- Heinz Galinski, chairman of the Berlin Jewish Community, called on East Germany to set aside a day in memory of the victims of Nazism.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The first joint Israeli-Egyptian peace commission held its initial meeting in Sinai April 29 mainly a ceremonial affair at which a timetable for future meetings was set, an agenda agreed to and a priority list of subjects to be discussed was drawn up.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The thousands who jammed Dag Hammarskjold Plaza across from the United Nations for the eighth annual "Solidarity Sunday for Soviet Jewry" April 29 joyously welcomed two Soviet Jews who were released from a Siberian prison camp only two days earlier and cheered as Sen. Henry M. Jackson (D. Wash.) and New York's two U.S. Senators declared that the Jackson - Vanik Amendment must not be repealed until the Soviet Union agrees to free emigration for all Jews and others who want to leave.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The allocations by Jewish Federations to day - schools are not keeping pace with burgeoning expenses because of increased enrollment, according to a nationwide study by the American Association for Jewish Education.

AMSTERDAM (WNS) -- Somon Wiesenthal, on his recent 70th birthday was made a commander in the Order of Orange Nassau. The award for the Nazi hunter was bestowed by the Dutch Ambassador in Vienna.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Aliya figures for March totaled 2992 compared to 1988 in March, 1978, an increase of 55 percent.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Plans are under way here to officially welcome the five Leningrad trial Prisoners of Conscience who were personally pardoned April 9 by Soviet President Leonid Brezhnev and released from prison more than a year before their 10 - year terms were due to expire in June 1980.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Two small children were among the four Israelis killed in a series of bloody shootouts with a seaborne gang of terrorists who invaded their homes on the Nahr-ya beachfront before dawn April 22.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Christians were urged to understand the Holocaust in order to prevent it from occurring again as the nation ended its eight - day long "Days of Remembrance of the Victims of the Holocaust" April 29.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- President Anwar Sadat of Egypt pledged May 1 to dispel "Israeli fears and suspicions." In a May Day speech at the Red Sea town of Safaga, Sadat declared that "if Israel makes one step forward, we shall match it with two steps to encourage it." Sadat attacked the 17 Arab states that broke relations with Egypt.

WASHINGTON, D.C. (WNS) -- President Carter was asked about the two new settlements in Samaria. He said he hoped Israel would "severely restrict" all new settlements in the West Bank and Gaza whether they are officially approved by the government or unofficially started by groups within Israel.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Amin Ebady, chairman of the Egyptian Student Organization at New York University, has invited Israeli students to participate in Egyptian Day Celebrations on the NYU campus May 9.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- President Carter's Commission on the Holocaust has announced that it has approved "in principle" recommendations from its subcommittee that a national memorial museum be established in Washington.
