Education Minister Zevulun Hammer declared at the ceremony that "The Holocaust stands before us as a note of warning .... that we must always remain aware of and be sensitive to any attempt to denigrate human lives. We, of all people, must sharpen our awareness to such atrocities.' The Ministry of Education announced that the Holocaust studies, which will be compulsory in high school next year, will focus on Judaism and not on Nazism.
