

**BEGIN SUPPORTS DEATH PENALTY FOR TERRORISTS**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin has added his voice to those who have called for the death penalty for terrorists following the death of four Israelis during a terrorist raid in Nahariya.

He told the Knesset Foreign Affairs and Security Committee April 24 that he supports capital punishment for terrorists in cases of "extreme cruel behavior" and said he would seek such

legislation. Begin was among the thousands who attended the funeral services at Tivon April 23 for Danny Aran, 28, and his daughters, Einat, 4, and Yael, 2, three of the four who died in Nahariya April 22. The Premier declared that whoever "kills a Jewish child shall pay with his life." The fourth victim, Police Sgt. Eliyahu Shachar was buried in Maalot with Defense Minister Ezer Weizman delivering the eulogy.

Meanwhile, Israeli forces have been pounding terrorist strongholds in south Lebanon as well as north of the Litani River. There have been continuous artillery attacks, the air force has hit terrorist artillery concentrations and Israeli missile boats have hit the coast near the Tyre area. The terrorists and Christian militia have also exchanged fire. Six persons in the south Lebanon village of Kle were killed when terrorists shelled a parade of the Christian militia. The terrorist rockets also hit the Israeli town of Kiryat Shemona. The terrorists charged that Israel and Christian militia have shelled the United Nations

Interim Force in Lebanon, a charge denied by Israel. Israel unleashed a heavy artillery attack against the Palestinian strongholds April 26 and then agreed to a ceasefire at UNIFIL's request.

The ceasefire came just before the United Nations Security Council was scheduled to meet in New York on the fighting at Lebanon's request. The Council meeting was brief with Norwegian Ambassador Ole Algard, its President, reading a statement expressing the Council's "deepest concern" over the growing tension in south Lebanon. The statement said the Security Council shared UN Secretary General Kurt Waldheim's "anxiety of the present situation in which UNIFIL is unable to implement its mandate" to help restore the authority of the Lebanese government over south Lebanon. Yehuda Blum, Israel's Ambassador to the UN, said later that "so long as the terrorist PLO enjoys complete freedom of movement in Lebanon, so long as the question of south Lebanon is artificially detached from Lebanon as a whole, so long as the PLO is able to abuse the presence of a United Nations peace-keeping force, there can be no solution to the problems of the area." Blum, in a letter to Waldheim April 23 protesting the terrorist raid on Nahariya, said Israel will "take all measures necessary to protect the lives and safety of its citizens." He criticized the UN for recognizing the PLO and working with it.

**PRES. NAVON URGES UNIFICATION**

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- President Yitzhak Navon urged Israelis April 24 to unite and eliminate "lands-manschaften," organizations of Jews from the same cities, towns or countries abroad. Speaking at a massive ceremony at Kibbutz Lohamei Hagetaot, the Ghetto Fighters Kibbutz, on Yom Hashoah, Martyrs and Heroes Remembrance Day, the President said that the enemy does not distinguish between Jews who speak Ladino and those who speak Yiddish. "Let us not differentiate between ourselves," he said. "The call of the hour is to unite." The ceremony at the kibbutz, which was attended by thousands of Holocaust survivors, students and school children, was one of many ceremonies

throughout the country. Places of entertainment were closed and flags were flown at half-mast. Traffic came to a halt for two minutes and pedestrians stopped and bowed their heads as sirens sounded at 8 a.m.

Yom Hashoah began at sundown April 23 with a memorial service at Yad Vashem. "The destruction of millions of Jews was paralled by no other in the history of mankind," Premier Menachem Begin told the audience. But it has shown us that our history is a circle. We rise and fall. We are freed and oppressed . . . a circle of construction, destruction, renewal, enslavement, uprising and victory." Begin called on the nation not to look to Masada as an example any more. "We must now ensure

that there will be no more destruction," he said. "No more destruction with honor. Rather honor with victory." The next morning, a memorial sculpture by Nandor Galid, one of Yugoslavia's most renowned sculptors, was dedicated at Yad Vashem. Education Minister Zevulun Hammer declared at the ceremony that "The Holocaust stands before us as a note of warning...that we must always remain aware of and be sensitive to any attempt to denigrate human lives. We, of all people, must sharpen our awareness to such atrocities." The Ministry of Education announced that the Holocaust studies, which will be compulsory in high school next year, will focus on Judaism and not on Nazism.
