JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Sen. Abraham A. Ribicoff (D. Conn.) has announced he intends to retire from the Senate when his term ends at the end of 1980.

TORONTO (WNS) -- Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau labelled as "totally irresponsible" for Joe Clark, leader of the opposition Progressive-Conservative Party, to declare that he would move the Canadian Embassy in Israel from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem if he becomes Prime Minister after this month's election.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Gerson Cohen, chancellor of the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, has announced he has agreed to requests by faculty members to defer until early next year a vote by the school Senate on whether to accept women as candidates for the Conservative rabbinate. The school was to have voted on the issue May 20.

BALTIMORE (WNS) -- Construction is expected to start this summer on the city's \$135,000 Holocaust Memorial.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Three Sovier officers serving with the United Nations observers force in Syria were in Israel May 5, the first such visit by Soviet military personnel.

BONN (WNS) -- Andreas von Schoeler, State Secretary in the Ministry of Interior, said here that membership in neo - Nazi groups in West Germany has more than doubled in the past three years, going from 600 in 1976 to 1300 this year.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Prof. Yusufu Lule, the new President of Uganda, has assured Israeli journalist Danny Bloch, son of the late Dora Bloch, that everything will be done to bring his mother's killers to justice.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel's population on its 31st anniversary was estimated at 3,760,000 by the Central Bureau of Statistics. This includes approximately 3,158,000 Jews and about 600,000 non - Jews. The Jewish population has increased by 490 percent since 1948 and the non - Jewish population by 384 percent.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Ronen Feldman, 16, of Patach Tikva, was the winner of the World Jewish Bible Quiz for youth held on Independence Day.

PARIS (WNS) -- Jewish residents of Dijon report that Palestinian air and ground crews, carrying Abu Dhabi passports, are being trained at a French air base near that city.

AMSTERDAM (WNS) -- The memorial tablet for the Jewish victims of the Holocaust at the "Gedempte Gracht" in the Hague was smeared with swastikas and the word "Jews."

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Natalia Braz, the 41 - year - old Russian refusnik who was "adopted" by Emunah Women of America last year, has received permission to immigrate to Israel.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Radio Free Europe conducted an interview with Archbishop Valerian Trifa, accused by eye - witnesses of instigating the Bucharest pogrom in January, 1941, which cost the lives of 1200 to 12,000 Jews.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Cabinet issued a strong statement May 6 declaring that "Jerusalem is the eternal, united, indivisible capital of the State of Israel."

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israeli Air Force planes attacked terrorist concentrations at Naher el Bared, near Tripoli, May 6. All Israeli planes returned safely.

LONDON (WNS) -- There is one Jew in the new Cabinet of Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher, Sir Keith Joseph, Minister of Industry.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The need for àdditional synagogues and other religious institutions in the Negev was stressed by Rabbi Ovadia Yosef, Israel's Chief Sephardic Rabbi.



NEW YORK (WNS) -- Amaokan-Edjampan Thienele, Ivory Coast's Ambassador to the United Nations, has expressed the hope that the peace treaty between Israel and Egypt will lead to the restoration of diplomatic relations

between Black African countries and Israel.
