

NEW NAZI HUNTER, A FORMER PROSECUTOR U.S. WILL DEAL WITH PALESTINIANS

WASH. (WNS) -- Walter Rockler, a 58-year-old former prosecutor in the Nuremberg trials, has been named head of the Justice Department's new unit to locate, denaturalize and deport Nazi war criminals living in the United States.

Rockler, a senior partner in the Washington law firm of Arnold and Porter, said that "There have been people who have suspected there are probably a fair

number of war criminals, Nazis, hanging around the U.S. It's probably worth looking into."

Nazi-hunter Simon Wiesenthal estimated during a recent visit to the U.S. that there may be as many as 3000 Nazi war criminals in the U.S. Rockler's appointment was welcomed by Rep. Elizabeth Holtzman, (D. N.Y.), chairman of the House Judiciary subcommittee dealing with Nazi war criminals. She said it was the "first step" in the Justice Department's promise to "honor its commitments in this country to upgrade and intensify efforts to bring Nazi war criminals in this country to justice." Holtzman said that more than 175 cases of alleged war criminals "require further study." She added that Martin Mendelsohn, who will be Rockler's deputy director, will now be able "to devote the bulk of his time to litigating the several important cases in which he is currently involved."

Mendelsohn headed the unit in the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) which was in charge of hunting war cri-

WASH. (WNS) -- The United States will deal with any Palestinian living on the West Bank and the Gaza Strip about the future of those areas, Secretary of State Cyrus Vance told the House Foreign Affairs Committee May 8.

But, he stressed that except for such matters as the security of the U.S. Embassy personnel in Beirut, the U.S. would not deal with the Palestine Liberation Organization until it accepts Security Council Resolution 242 and recognizes Israel's right to exist. "We are free to discuss with the people of the West Bank -- for example, mayors -- without regard to what their politics are, as long as they are residents of the West Bank and Gaza," Vance said. He and Defense Secretary Harold Brown were testifying before the committee on the Carter Administration's

minerals. Holtzman and others in Congress criticized the INS for lack of action and urged a shift to the Justice Department with a larger staff and more funding.

proposal to provide Israel \$3 billion and Egypt \$1 billion in aid as part of the Egyptian-Israeli peace treaty.

Rep. Gerry Studds (D. Mass.) said \$35 million should be reduced from the appropriation for Israel to penalize it for building two new settlements on the West Bank. The \$35 million is understood to be the cost of the two settlements recently authorized by the Israeli Cabinet.

RAPID TOURISM BETWEEN ISRAEL AND EGYPT

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Tourism between Israel and Egypt "will develop much faster than we imagine," Gideon Patt, Israel's Minister of Industry, Trade and Tourism predicted here.

He told a press luncheon that before long thousands of Israeli and Egyptian tourists will be exchanging visits. He said that once the borders between Egypt and Israel are opened May 27 "it will be a question of days, maybe weeks" before the flow of tourism starts. He predicted that within a three-month period after May 27

land links will be established between the two countries. The present plans are for an air link only.

Patt said the Israeli tourist facilities in Sinai, particularly along the Red Sea, would continue to operate during the three years that Israel will be engaged in withdrawing from the area. He said his ministry is "toying with the idea" of reaching some agreement with Egypt that would allow those facilities to remain.
