AMBASSADOR BLUM WARNS UNITED NATIONS THAT ISRAEL WILL TAKE ANY AND ALL MEASURES AGAINST PLO

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- Ambassador Yehudah Z. Blum has warned this organization that, in the face of unceasing terrorist attacks, Israel will continue to "take all measures necessary to protect the lives and safety of its citizens.'

In a letter submitted to Secretary-General Waldheim last week, Ambassador Blum gave the following account of the recent criminal PLO actions:

"On June 4, 1979, a coastal patrol of the Israeli Navy intercepted a speedboat attempting to enter Israel waters off Rosh Hanikra on the border with Lebanon. A number of missiles were spotted aboard and the boat was ordered to stop. When it resisted and tried to make off, it was engaged in an exchange of fire in the course of which it sank. In the wreckage, a. floating rocket launcher was found with a delaying
