concerned" about the "further escalation of hostilities in and over Lebanon." He urged "all parties concerned to exercise restraint and to give their cooperation to the establishment of an effective cease - fire in the area. Damascus Radio did not mention the dogfight for at least three hours after it happened.

It admitted that four Syrian planes had been hit but claimed that two Israeli planes were shot down. Israel and Syria have not clashed since the separation of forces agreement on the Golan Heights was signed five years ago. Gen. Yehoshua Saguy, Chief of Israeli Military Intelligence, said it is believed that Syria decided to intervene because of internal problems and because the Arab League is scheduled to decide the future of the Syrian - led force in Lebanon.

The first U.S. reaction came from State Department spokesman Tom Reston in Washington who said the use of American - made aircraft "has been of serious concern to us and to members of Congress." Reston said the U.S. was not in a position to place blame for the battle but "We call on both Israel and Syria to exercise maximum restraint." Lewis later presented a State Department note to Begin whose contents were not revealed. The Premier reportedly told him, "We did not want the en-

counter." Begin said the Syrian command ordered its planes "to interfere with Israel's legitimate action. Israel is protecting its women and children."

ISRAEL HAS TERRORISTS ON RUN

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israel has the Palestinian terrorist on the run, Premier Menachem Begin declared during a two-day tour of the Galilee. "The initiative in south Lebanon is in our hands now," he told some 10,000 persons in the border town of Kiryat She-mona.

"We have the strength to hit the terrorists until they stop the bloodshed. And now they are fleeing. We do not retaliate any more. We hit them once or even twice a day according to our decision and anytime."

He said the terrorists are sought out to prevent them from launching attacks in Israel. "But this is not done overnight," he stressed. During his trip, Begin met with Maj. Saad Haddad, commander of the Christian militia in south Lebanon, and reiterated Israel's pledge not to desert the Christians who are battling the Palestinians.

DAYAN HAS MALIGNANT TUMOR

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The tumor removed from Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan's intestines was malignant, it was reported. But Dr. Boleslav Goldmann, Director of Tel Hashomer Hospital, where Dayan is hospitalized, said

there is no indication that the cancer has spread.

Goldmann said Dayan was the first person to hear the results. Dayan was later visited by Premier Menachem Begin. Dayan is expected to be back at work in three weeks.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The remains of 11 Israeli soldiers listed as missing in action since the 1973 Yom Kippur War were turned over to Israel by Egypt at a somber ceremony in El Arish June 25. The remains were taken to Tel Hashomer Hospital near Tel Aviv where the difficult task of trying to identify them will be conducted. There are still 12 more Israeli soldiers missing since the war.
