at world market prices. Begin also announced that Sadat has ordered Egyptian officials to grant entry visas to all Israelis who have applied for them and that after more than 30 years the old railroad line between Cairo and Lod in Israel

may be reopened.

Begin arrived in Alexandria to be welcomed by Egyptian Vice President Hosni Mubarak and Deputy Premier Fkiri Makram Obeid. There was a thick line of security men along the roads leading from the airport to downtown Alexandria where Begin was taken to the official guest house. Several pedestrians waved friendly greetings but there were no throngs or posters as there were when Begin visited Cairo April 1. Begin had two long meetings with Sadat.

Both leaders also attended a dinner hosted by Egyptian Prime Minister Mustapha Khalil Terre Fleener, a 24where the two Prime Ministers achieved a

reconciliation. Relations between the two had soured ever since Begin refused to fly to Washington earlier this year to meet Khalil and President Carter.

The Israeli press plane that followed Begin's plane from Alexandria brought the first Egyptian Jews to benefit from another promise Sadat made Begin, exit visas to Egyptian Jews who want to visit their families in Israel. Aboard the press plane were Robert Dassa, a 46-year-old television reporter who served 14 years in an Egyptian prison for membership in an Israeli spy ring that attempted various acts of sabotage in Egypt in 1954; his sister, Awda, and her three daughters. They were invited to come to Israel by Begin who met them in Alexandria.

NEW YORK (WNS) year-old woman from
