WILL U.S. SEEK PLO RELATIONS DESPITE YOUNG'S RESIGNATION?

AMBASSADOR TO AUSTRIA ALSO MET WITH PLO

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israeli officials are still suspicious that the United States is seeking some way of bringing the Palestine Liberation Organization into the Middle East negotiations despite the resignation of Andrew Young as the U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations for an unauthorized meeting with the PLO's observer at the UN. The Israelis are stressing that any meetings with the PLO are a violation of U.S. commitments to Israel.

Deputy Premier Yigael Yadin, now in the U.S. on a 10-day visit, warned that "if ever the PLO will be recognized by some others as a partner to the peace negotiations, that means Israel will be out of the game." He said the meeting between Young and Zehadi Labib Terzi, the PLO observer at the UN was "an obvious such departure" from the Israeli-Egyptian peace treaty.

The Israelis are also concerned that not only did Young meet a PLO official in New York but the U.S. Ambassador to Austria, Milton Wolf, had three unauthorized meetings in Vienna with a PLO official. Israel regards yesterday's UN Security Council meeting as a test of the American position. It is demanding that the U.S. veto any resolution that would change Security Council Resolution 242 and 338.

However, Israel had no official comment on

Andy's Exit

Andrew Young personified both the best and the worst in President Carter's Administration.

On one hand, a southern President appoints a Black as Ambassador to the United Nations. This post, once held by America's silver-tongued Adlai Stevenson, now has been demeaned and ridiculed for the first time in three and a half decades of UN history. And Carter's man has resigned in disgrace.

Andrew Young has on three or four occasions blurted out statements which embarrassed Carter and the American people. This latest and most serious error caused Carter to ask for his resignation. Why?

Young secretly met with a representative of the PLO, then lied about the meeting when asked by the State Department.

The meeting was a brazen, audacious slap in the face to Israelis and Americans, but the attempted cover-up brought all the ugly Watergate memories to the fore.

He had to go -- and did, friendship with the President taking a back seat to the welfare of Jews and Gentiles alike.

Normally, a secret meeting would be welcomed. What harm could come from talking? After all, some will say, isn't that what the United Nations is all about?

By our view, the PLO is not worthy of being recognized in ANY discussion or peace initiative, for the following reasons:

1. They refuse to even recognize Israel's RIGHT TO EXIST! (In other words, they want Israel wiped off the map.)

2. They have demonstrated a hundred times over, that they are terrorists, murderers and killers of innocent children!

3. They are the SAME Jew-haters who, in 1948, encouraged the Palestinian people to leave quickly when a half dozen Arab armies converged on the new State of Israel.

Leave the battlefield, the PLO promised, and we'll push the Jews into the sea in six weeks. Then, you'll return and resume your lives. Today, 31 years later, these are the several million displaced persons who now regret leaving (voluntarily), and who wish to return. The PLO's "six weeks" is now 32 years.

So here we are. The United States, Israel and every responsible nation ignores the PLO as a band of killers. Delicate negotiations have brought Egypt and Israel to the verge of a real peace.

In one fell swoop, Andrew Young has nearly smashed this precious understanding into a million pieces. Now, Carter is trying to pick
