TERRORIST TRIAL STIRS EMOTIONS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Emotions are running high at the trial of the two surviving members of the terrorist gang which hijacked a bus on the Tel - Aviv - Haifa coastal road and killed 37 people. The courtroom of the military tribunal here is crowded with survivors and relatives of victims, many of whom can be heard sobbing as testimony is given about the murders of their loved ones. The two terrorists, Halad Housein, 18, and Housein Fuad, 19, show no remorse.

Instead, they gesture and spit at the audience and smile and even laugh when witnesses describe the atrocities committed by the terrorists. There are frequent outbursts from the audience,

aimed not so much at the defendants, but their Jewish lawyer, Leah Zemel.

These outbursts became especially vehement when one witness, Ethel Sacherbrott, an elderly woman, who was wounded by the terrorists fainted while being cross-examined. Mrs. Sacherbrott testified on how after a woman was killed in the hijacked bus other passengers tried to take her baby from her arms. Instead, a woman terrorist seized the infant and threw it into the burning part of the bus. Esther Avi - Assaf, 14, another passenger on the bus, said she saw the two defendants throwing grenades as the passengers tried to escape from the burning bus.

She said the terrorists used her as a shield but she escaped when she was let go as a terrorist threw a grenade at a wounded passenger. Col. Aharon Halperin, head of the military tribunal, has tried to maintain decorum in the courtroom. Witnesses were instructed to answer questions from Mrs. Zemel and persons who shouted at her were removed from the courtroom.

SUPPORT YOUR LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE NOW IN 15TH YEAR.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- The United States announced that it was stepping up its efforts to end the violence in south Lebanon. The announcement came as its Ambassador to the United Nations, Andrew Young, charged that Israeli attacks in south Lebanon caused the "slaughter of innocent people through random violence."

Young, who addressed the Security Council debate convened at the request of Lebanon, also condemned violence by Palestinian terrorists. The Ambassador, who resigned two weeks earlier after his unauthorized meeting with the UN observer of the Palestinian Liberation Organization, declared that he was speaking "with the full authority of the United States government." Young, who was also Council president during August, said the U.S. condemns terrorist attacks against Israel and that "no political objective can ever justify such barbarism." He declared that "Just as strongly we condemn the policy of artillery shelling and preemptive attacks on Lebanese towns, villages and refugee camps which Israel and the arms Lebanese groups Israel supports have followed in recent months.

Let there be no doubt or ambiguity about this. We cannot and do not agree with Israel's military policies in Lebanon as manifested in the past few months. They are wrong and unacceptable to my government. They are painfully at variance with the values which Israel has traditionally espoused." He said "Israel should end its policy of preemptive strikes on Lebanese soil" and cease its artillery attacks "in support of Lebanese militia groups." He
