Most Vital Issue

With the start of the school year, it is opportune to turn our attention to the importance of Jewish education. The question of Jewish education is the most vital issue in Jewish life today, for on it depends the survival of the Jewish people.

Every Jewish community in the United States, and throughout the world for that matter, must strive to ensure that every Jewish child has a proper Jewish education. The situation is somewhat better now than it was a few years ago. Jewish Federations are increasing the percentage of the funds they give for education, although it is still inadequate. The day school movement is growing Just as important, more adults are taking parttime courses in Jewish education.

All this is of course not enough. The growing figure on intermarriage and assimilation proves this. It is still a disgrace how many American Jews, even those active in Jewish life, know so little about Judaism, Jewish history or Jewish culture.

Israeli officials have been strong critics of the lack of Jewish education in the United States and other diaspora countries because they know that the future of Israel and the Jewish people depends on having committed Jews, Jews tied to their own people through a sense of common heritage. But Israel must also be faulted for the poor education Israeli youth are given about the diaspora, especially the American Jewish community.

With a new Hebrew year approaching, all of us should pledge to work toward increasing our own knowledge as well as that of our children.

Behind The Scenes At The United Nations

Latest Crisis

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- The Israeli Mission to the UN released a most significant 'background paper' in connection with the latest crisis arising out of attempts by the Arabs and their friends here to introduce a new Security Council resolution that would open the door for the PLO to join in the peace negotiations and give them a major role to play versus the Jewish State.

The 'paper' -- captioned "Resolution 242" -- was handed to this writer and several other correspondents who had attended Ambassador Yehuda Blum's press briefing at which he gave a full accounting of the 90 - minute meeting he had had with Ambassador Andrew Young at the Israeli Mission headquarters. Young, himself, following the storm created by his encounter with the UN PLO spoke'sman Terzi and which action prompted Carter to accept his resignation, had requested the meeting.

Following are some of the highlights of the "background paper":

"Recently we have witnessed moves by Arab countries, with the consent of various parties, to induce the Security Council to adopt a resolution that would impair Security Council Resolution 242 of November 1947, add elements to it and change its meaning. Israel vigorously opposes any such move. This paper explains our major reasons.

The draft proposal is contrary to Resolution 242 and will leave it devoid of con-

Resolution 242 is the only resolution accepted by all the States that are a party to the Middle East conflict, including Syria,

In January 1976 an attempt to get through the Security Council a draft similar to that being readied today failed.

"4. The proposed change is an attempt to destroy the Camp David Accords.

"A. Resolutions 242 and 338 are explicitly mentioned by the parties as the legal basis for the Israel - Egyptian Disengagement Agreement of 1974, the Israel - Syrian Disengagement of 1974, the Israel - Egyptian Interim Agreement of 1975.

"B. In the preamble to the Camp David Accords, it is stated: 'The agreed basis for a peaceful settlement of the conflict between Israel and its neighbors is Security Council Resolution 242 in all its parts,' and the texts of Resolution 242 and 338 were appended as annexes to the Camp David Accords.

"C. The adoption by the Security Council of a resolution defining the right of the Palestinians to self - determination or to an independent state would be an attempt to demolish the Camp David Framework Agreement, since such a resolution, if adopted, would stipulate in advance the outcome of the negotiations that are to be conducted towards the end of the fiveyear transitional period. Israel, Jordan and the Palestinian Arabs resident in Judea-Samaria and Gaza are to determine the status of these territories.

"D. It is stated in the Camp David Agreement that the solution to be found for the Palestinian problem must also take into account the legitimate rights of the Palestinian people. Israel never consented that the solution is to be based exclusively on the legitimate rights but only on those rights; any element wrenched from the Camp David Agreement would violate its structure and conception regarding this and other issues.


