and clearly stated that we wish to faithfully carry out this commitment, too, as we undertook and signed its provisions. The negotiations meet sometimes with difficulties but these can be removed if all parties to the talks observe the written agreement which is clear and cannot be misinterpreted.

Here I will register a truth that is obvious to the Jewish people and deserving of the support of every woman and man of goodwill everywhere: Jerusalem is the capital of Israel, an indivisible city with complete freedom of access to the holy shrines by members of all religions, guaranteed by law for all time.

And from this city, eternal Yerushalayim, I send you, my dear brethren, greetings for a Happy New Year, 5740. May it be, with God's help, a year of a general comprehensive peace, a year of aliyah to the land of our forefathers, of progress towards the solution of our economic difficulties and first and foremost of housing for the needy families. May this Rosh HaShanah bring peace, security, freedom and happiness to all the Jewish people in Eretz Israel and in the diaspora.

UGANDA'S NEW BOSS TALKS ABOUT AMIN

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- During a press conference here last week, Gofray L. Binaisa, the new President of Uganda, was asked by the WUP correspondent if he would care to comment on Idi Amin's behavior or misbehavior during the world-shaking Israeli operation at Entebbe.

Smiling and following a brief pause, he replied, "It's a pity no one got him then," implying that Amin should have been among the slain during the raid.

President Binaisa said he was in the United States to seek financial aid from the U.S. and the UN so that he could rebuild his nation.

ARAFAT'S WORST ENEMY IS HIMSELF

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Yasir Arafat, head of the Palestine Liberation Organization, refused in a television interview to say whether a Palestinian state would agree to coexist with Israel. Although repeatedly pressed for a straight answer by interviewer Barbara Walters on ABC's "Issues and Answers" Arafat would only say that the decision would have to be made by a Palestinian state itself. The interview was in Havana where Arafat was attending the conference of non-aligned nations and shown on ABC.

When asked whether the PLO would abandon its call for the elimination of Israel, Arafat replied that this was a foolish question since Israel has a "huge force" with 15 - 20 atomic weapons backed by the United States. He denied the Palestine Charter calls for the elimination of Israel.

Arafat again accused Egyptian President Anwar Sadat of "betrayal" of the Arab people. He said evidence of this was that when Sadat's yacht sailed into Haifa last week

it was guarded by Israeli planes, the same planes that bomb "my people" and the Lebanese people in Lebanon.

Arafat denied he was anti-Semitic. "We are anti-Zionist." We respect the Jews and the Jewish religion." He characterized Zionism as expansionist. Walters, who was irked throughout the interview by Arafat's refusal to directly state whether the Palestinians could exist with Israel, noted that the PLO seemed to be getting more support in the U.S. but at the same time Americans did not want to see Israel destroyed. Arafat again refused to give a direct answer implying only that Israel was strong enough to prevent its destruction.

On the issue of Andrew Young's resignation as U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations, Arafat at first said he agreed with a statement by a PLO official that the resignation has increased anti-Semitism in the U.S.
