

# JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

PARIS (WNS) -- Jean-Pierre Bloch, president of the International League Against Racism and Anti-Semitism (LICA) charged that Libyan leader Col. Muammar Qaddafi is financing the distribution of virulent anti-Semitic material in France and throughout Europe through a cult known as the "Family of God." Bloch said LICA has already filed complaints against the cult in Paris and Grenoble where anti-Semitic cartoons and leaflets have been appearing.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The President's Commission on the Holocaust presented President Carter with its recommendations for a museum in Washington on the Holocaust, continuing education programs and annual days of remembrance for the six million Jews and five million others who perished in the Holocaust.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Six persons were injured when a bomb exploded on Allenby Road, the main thoroughfare in the center of Tel Aviv. Three of the injured were released after being treated. The explosion took place a short distance from the open-air Carmel Market where a bomb exploded earlier in the day. There were no injuries in that incident.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israel has released Ludvinna Jannsen, the 26-year-old Dutch woman sentenced in 1977 for planning to carry out a terrorist act for the Palestine Liberation Organization here. She was released after serving only one-third of her six-year sentence at the request of the Dutch government.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A bomb exploded in the Rondon coffee house in downtown Jerusalem, only several hundred yards from where another bomb exploded killing one person and injuring 50 others. There were no injuries in the latest incident.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Lt. Gideon Eshet was jailed for 14 days for refusing to serve in the occupied areas for "political reasons." Military sources said this is believed to be the first case of its kind.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Member organizations of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations that have overseas travel programs are considering a boycott or other action against Spain following the Madrid government's recent enthusiastic reception of Palestine Liberation Organization chief Yasir Arafat.

CINCINNATI (WNS) -- Sheldon Benjamin, interim-chairperson of the Coalition for Alternatives in Jewish Education (CAJE), said here that it was incorrectly reported at the CAJE conference at Rutgers University in New Jersey that 40 teachers in the Soviet Union had formed a CAJE chapter.

PARIS (WNS) -- Jewish financier Samuel Flatto - Sharon, a member of the Israeli Knesset, was sentenced in absentia by a Paris court to a five-year prison term and a \$7,000 fine for illicit financial operations. About 25 accomplices received suspended sentences.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The Habima National Theatre has announced it will name its auditorium after Hanna Rovina, who has been a member of the group since she joined it in Moscow in 1918. The announcement was timed for her 90th birthday.

BUENOS AIRES (WNS) -- A bomb exploded outside a rabbinical seminary here, causing property damage. Seminary officials said seven students were inside the building, located in the center of the city, when the bomb exploded, but no one was injured.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The latest dispute between Israel's two chief rabbis is whether Jewish law permits Israel to give up territory for peace. In a lecture at the Oral Law Conference at Yad Harav Kook here, Sephardic Chief Rabbi Ovadia Yosef said it was up to the generals and politicians to decide on Israel's orders. He said that as far as Jewish law is concerned if retaining the territories meant war when the concept of "Pikuah Nefesh" (risk to life) applied over the mitzvah of retaining all of Eretz Israel. But at a rally in Safed the next day, Ashkenazic Chief Rabbi Shlomo Goren insisted that the mitzvah of holding onto Eretz Israel was paramount.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A security dragnet in the Gaza Strip has resulted in the arrests of some 70 local residents on suspicion of belonging to or organizing terrorist cells -- among them the son of Dr. Haider Abdul-Shafi, one of two pro-PLO Palestinian leaders with whom Defense Minister Moshe Dayan met recently "to exchange views." An Army spokesman confirmed that Tarik Haider el-Shafi, 19, was detained for alleged membership in El Fatah, the terrorist arm of the PLO. He said more arrests are expected.
