Evening services on Saturday will begin at 6:00 P.M. and the traditional "Hafkofos" will commence at 6:30 P.M. Sisterhood will treat the children to holidays flags and the entire congregation to special holiday treats. On Simchat Torah Day, Sunday, Oct. 14, services will begin

at 9:00 A.M. Rabbi Kalman Appel, spiritual leader of the congregation, will conduct all services and deliver the special holiday sermons. Cantor Simon Bergman will chant the liturgy.

Kaufman stated that the Jewish community is cordially invited to attend and participate in any and all services and to visit the Succah which is located on the rear grounds of the Temple.

SANTINI ANNOUNCES HUD APARTMENT COMPLEX

Construction of 226 apartment units in Las Vegas by Paradise Development Company under a commitment by the Department of Housing and Urban Development has been announced by Nevada Representative Jim Santini, with completion slated for next year.

Part of a unique nation-wide program designed in part to enable qualified residents of the community to up-grade their living environment beyond what their income would generally allow, The Mission Apartments will be a mix of one, two and three bedroom units.

The 10-acre site at Katie and Algonquin Streets is adjacent to the Boulevard Mall and other shopping areas as well as public transportation and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

Irwin Molasky, General Partner of Paradise Development, praised Santini for his "outstanding efforts in having our area recognized by HUD for this program."

"We have done out utmost to design an environmentally pleasing atmosphere where apartment occupants can enjoy the privacy and other advantages usually enjoyed only by home owners," Molasky said.

In addition, Molasky said, the program will allow Paradise Development Co., "to maintain its own first-class, quality standards and still compete with moderate rental scales." He said his firm had experienced "impressive" cooperation and involvement in the project from the San Francisco office of FHA over the past 18 months.

Plight of Soviet Jews

NEW YORK -- Burton S. Levinson, Chairman of the National Conference on Soviet Jewry (NCSJ), issued this New Year message:

"Soviet Jews today are a people who face a bitter irony -- they are not permitted to be Jews, nor are they permitted to stop being Jews.

"Despite ongoing harassment by Soviet authorities, a blatant anti-Semitic campaign in the Soviet media and trials against those attempting to exercise their basic human rights, Soviet Jews have displayed imaginative and ongoing courage...a courage we must match with our solidarity.

"The last decade has witnessed a historic exodus of Soviet Jews. Since 1967, more than 200,000 have left the USSR to rejoin their families in Israel and elsewhere. But their departure represents only the tip of the iceberg, for thousands more daily petition Soviet authorities for their right to leave the USSR, with all cultural and religious rights accorded other minorities by Soviet law. Our latest calculations indicate that only one in six visa applications are being approved. So, while more Jews will leave the Soviet Union this year than any in the past, far more are also being refused.

CARTER SAYS ISRAEL SHOULD DEFEND ITSELF

-- Israel has the right to defend itself "against terrorism from the north and against her neighbors from the east and south," President Carter declared. Answering questions at a "town meeting" at Queens College, the President was asked why he opposes Israel's right to defend itself against Palestine Liberation Organization terrorist incursions into Israel when the U. S. would not tolerate terrorist attacks from Cuba.

"Any nation has a right to defend itself, obviously, including Israel," Carter replied. "A basis of the Camp David accords was the right of Israel to defend itself, a right of Israel to be secure and along with that was a commitment made by President (Anwar) Sadat (of Egypt) and myself and Prime Minister (Menachem) Begin of Israel that the Palestinian question in all its aspects would be resolved, that the Palestinian people have a right to a voice in the determination of their own future, but at the same time Sadat agreed on behalf of many Arabs that Israel would have a right to defend itself."
