BEGIN RESHUFFLES CABINET IN WAKE OF DAYAN QUITTING

PREMIER MAY NAME NEW DEPUTY MINISTER

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin has succeeded in reshuffling his Cabinet in the wake of the resignation of Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan naming Yigal Hurwitz as Finance Minister, and the present Finance Minister Simcha Ehrlich, as a second Deputy Premier.

Begin will continue to serve temporarily as Foreign Minister although he may name a deputy minister to assist him. The new government was drafted by Begin, Ehrlich, Deputy Premier Yigael Yadin of the Democratic Movement and Interior Minister Yosef Burg.

Yadin had earlier officially rejected an offer to become Foreign Minister and Burg who had also been mentioned for the post said he preferred to remain in the Interior Ministry.

Ehrlich, a leader of the Liberal Party, had been under heavy criticism for his handling of the economy. Hurwitz, a member of the small ultranational Laam faction of Likud, had resigned as Commerce Minister last year because of his opposition to the Camp David agreement. Begin also announced that Minister - Without - Portfolio Moshe Nissim, a member of the Liberal Party, will become Minister of Information, a new post in the Begin government.

Whoa... Valley Times

The Valley Times, a local daily newspaper, stepped out of its league the other day when it ran an editorial entitled, "Maybe Americans Don't Want Leadership." The editorial tried to show how presidential hopeful John Connally can offer leadership by his recent "formula" for a lasting peace in the Middle East.

Let's show you what the Valley Times had to say about this candidate and his Middle East formula and what the ISRAELITE feels about the man and the subject. You be the judge.

The Times talks about Americans yearning for "dynamic, strong leadership," in the future. They say, "A case in point is John Connally, a man who wants to be president and offers as his prime ingredient his leadership potential which has attracted most of his early supporters."

The ISRAELITE says, this is the same man who started out as a Democrat from Texas. He was such a leader, he jumped ship in midstream and became a Republican. How's that for a gutty guy that really "knows" his own mind.

The Valley Times continues, "A few weeks ago, Connally tried to offer some leadership by suggesting a formula for a lasting peace in the Middle East. It was a controversial proposal, which produced howls of anguish from those who believe that Israel's well being would be jeopardized by the Connally plan."

The ISRAELITE feels this was not an offer of leadership but the ranting of a horse trader from Texas. We'll show you why.

The Times editorial continued, "The most objectionable portion of the proposal... would require the withdrawal of Israel from the Golan Heights, the Gaza Strip and the West Bank. But in return for these losses, Israel alone would be permitted to maintain a military presence in the abandoned regions, and would be recognized by Jordan and Syria."

What gall! The Heights, Strip and Bank were won by the loss of thousands of lives. Their strategic military importance is as a buffer zone to protect civilian Israelis from the sneak attacks of murdering terrorists. Yet Connally would allow Israel to maintain a military presence there. What does he think Israel does now? Pray that these areas will increase for real estate development. Of course, Israel keeps a military presence in these areas -- and a strong one to be sure.
