KEEP CANADIAN EMBASSY IN ISRAEL

OTTAWA (WNS) ---Prime Minister Joe Clark announced that he has dropped his plans to move Canadian Embassy in Israel from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem, a move he had promised in last May's election cam-paign. He said the decision was based on the recommendations in an interim report from Robert Stanfield, the former leader of Clark's Progressive Conservative Party who has just returned from a six - weeks trip to the Middle East as Clark's special ambassador to discuss the proposed move with Israel and Arab countries.

"As a result of extensive consultations, Mr. Stanfield has concluded that a change in the location of the Canadian Embassy in Israel could be seen as prejudging the negotiations among parties in the Middle East," Clark said, "The move might, in fact, work against progress towards a just and lasting peace. The go-vernment accepts the recommendation that no action be taken until the status of Jerusalem is clarified within a comprehensive between agreement Israel and its neighbors."

In his preliminary report, Stanfield said Canada could not use "whatever fluence we may have in the (Middle East) area to encourage moderation and compromise" without retaining credibility with both sides.""We could not do this if we were to move our Embassy to Jerusalem," Stanfield maintained.


