ACTION TAKEN AFTER SHAKA SUPPORTS PLO

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Ministerial Defense Committee ordered the deportation of West Bank Mayor Bassam Shaka of Nablus. However, the final decision rests with the Supreme Court which had issued a temporary injunction against his expulsion. The ministerial committee decision approved the decision made earlier by Premier Menachem Begin and Defense Minister Ezer Weizman to deport the mayor, an outspoken supporter of the Palestine Liberation Organization, after Shaka reportedly said he fully supported the action of the PLO terrorists who massacred 34 Israelis on the Tel Aviv-Haifa highway in March, 1978.

Shaka's statement was made in a private conversation with Gen Darny Matt, military coordinator of the administered territories. Shaka, who was jailed after his wife got an injunction seeking to bar his deportation, said he only said he understood why there was terror-
