permanence and security of the State of Israel, the Vice President said: "We will not succumb to blackmail over Israel or over oil, nor will we succumb to it in Iran.

"I stand before you tonight representing the President of the United States and I say to you that we will stand by Israel always." That means, Mondale said, that "we're committed to an undivided Jerusalem with free access to the holy places for all faiths."

He continued: "We are committed to reliable economic and military aid to Israel, and never once did we threaten that aid at any time during this Administration -- nor will we. We are committed to peace between Israel and all of its neighbors. We are committed to being full partners in negotiations toward a comprehensive settlement in the Middle East.

"We are against the creation of a separate Palestinian state," Mr. Mondale said. "It would not contribute to a stable peace.

"We will not negotiate with the PLO and we will not recognize the PLO -- unless it first recognizes the right of Israel to exist, and accepts U.N., resolutions 242 and 338." The Vice President continued:

"It is past time for the PLO to recognize Israel. It is past time for a total end to terrorism against Israel. That is the basis for peace. And we must insist that everyone ac-

As Israel, Egypt and the United States continue to work toward a "lasting Middle East peace," the Vice President conceded that "there will be problems." But, he added, "never will the security of Israel be compromised in that process.'

The Vice President concluded: "We will never barter any element of a Middle East settlement for oil. We will never trade assurances of petroleum supplies or prices for Israeli security. Peace in the Middle East is not for sale. And succumbing to blackmail is not the American way."
