ORTHODOX GROUPS

OPPOSE

FEMALE DRAFT

NEW YORK (WNS)

-- Eleven national Orthodox Jewish organizations have written President Carter in opposition to including women in any national registration for the reactivation of the draft. The groups, claiming to represent the entire spectrum of American Orthodox Judaism, have formed an Orthodox Jewish Coalition on Registration of Women for the Selective Service System. "The highest rabbinic authorities have ruled that Jewish Law prohibits Jewish women from responding to any form of conscription," the coalition told President.

PRAISES ISRAEL AS DEMOCRACY WITH HIGH STANDARDS OF JUSTICE

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The State Department, in its annual report to Congress on human rights conditions in 154 countries, praised Israel as a "parliamentary democracy with high standards of justice and human rights," but said some of these rights were "suspended" in the occupied territories for security reasons.

"This dichotomy poses a dilemma that will be probably resolved only in the context of a final peace settlement between Israel and its neighbors," the report noted. The 853-page report is the most comprehensive issued by the Department since unlike previous years it includes all members of the United Nations not
