### KENNEDY CALLS ERROR A "SHAMEFUL" MOMENT

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The Carter Administration's policy on the Middle East appears to be in confusion following President Carter's repudiation of the vote by the United States in the United Nations Security Council for a resolution condemning Israel's settlement policies in the occupied territories. Early this month, Carter attributed the vote by U.S. Ambassador Donald McHenry to a "failure" in communication.

Secretary of State Cyrus Vance assumed direct responsibility. "The Secretary accepts full responsibility for the foul-up," a State Department spokesman said. The Israelis were angry by the U.S. vote and the Cabinet denounced the UN resolution as "repugnant" and expressed "deep resentment toward the U.S. for supporting it."

In a statement to the Knesset, Premier Menachem Begin accepted Carter's explanation that the U.S. vote had been case in error on the assumption that a paragraph referring to Jerusalem had been deleted from the resolution. But he urged the U.S. to repudiate all of the resolution. "It goes without saying that
