repeated his charge that a "Gang" of Five" in the Carter Administration was anti - Israel and was behind the United States vote March I for the anti - Israel resolution in the United Nations Security Council. He has identified the five as Secretary of State Cyrus Vance, National Security Advisor Zbigniew Brzezinski, Assis-tant Secretary of State for Near East and South Asian Affairs Harold Saunders, UN Ambassador Donald McHenry and former UN Ambassador Andrew Young.

BONN (WNS) -- A Munich court acquitted two West German officers of charges involving a 1977 incident in which cadets in a military college sang Nazi songs and shouted "throw another Jew on the fire" as they burned pieces of paper. The court ruled that Col. Edgar Munks and Maj. Hans - Joachim Stabenau should not be held criminally responsible for the incident for which Il cadets were disciplined.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Stuart Eizenstat, Assistant to President Carter for Domestic Affairs and Policy, described HIAS as "a modern Moses for the Jewish people in bondage, helping people reach a land of freedom and land of opportunity." He told the 300 persons attending a Centennial Dinner marking HIAS 100 years of rescue and resettlement of more than four million Jews, that the organization "made America a nation of nations."

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- More than 200 Israeli soldiers were needed to evict some 30 Gush Emunim quatters from a hill in northern Sinai where they attempted to establish a "settlement" in defiance of the government.

NEW YORK CITY -- At ceremonies in the Georgian Ballroom of the Sheraton Centre Hotel, Rabbi Judah Washer was installed into office as President of the New York Board of Rabbis. At the installation ceremonies all of the officers and members of the Board of Governors were officially installed into office.

UNITED NATIONA (WUP) -- It was disclosed here last week that PLO terrorists, termed by the UN as "armed elements," had broken through several UNIFIL - protected areas and engaged in combat with some of Major Haddad's Free Christian forces. The UN, based on a cable from the region, noted that, as a result of PLO infiltrations, Mayor Haddad's "De Facto Forces fired three artillery rounds to the Nabatiyah area.'

NEW YORK -- A major educational institution in Israel, Ben Gurion University of the Negev, has renamed its Institute for Desert Research in memory of Jacob Blaustein, the late former President of the American Jewish Committee,
