Remember the Holocaust

If there is one thing that stands out in Holocaust literature it is a desire by the victims to ensure that the murder by the Nazis of six million Jewish men, women and children as well as five million non - Jews will not be forgotten by the world. Many Jewish inmates of death camps feared not only that they personally would be forgotten but so would the Nazi crimes against them. Many Holocaust victims survived their ordeal principally because of a determination to live in order to bear witness.

This is what makes the denial of the Holocaust by neo - Nazis so infuriating. It is not that any but a few misguided souls will actually believe. It is that the actual voicing of this denial is a desecration of those who were so brutally murdered.

This is why it is a welcome development that the observance of Yom Hashoah, Holocaust Remembrance Day, which this year is April 13, is becoming almost universally accepted on the Jewish calendar. The day is important because it not only pays tribute to the martyrs who died in the Holocaust but also remembers the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising and other acts of Jewish resistance during the Nazi reign of terror.

The central theme of Yom Hashoah has always been that the Holocaust must never beallowed to happen again whether as an attempt to destroy Israel or to endanger Jews in any country in which they live.

But the day also reminds us that not only Jews must be on guard. As the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Commission said: "when evil is unleashed against one people, all are engulfed in the fire.'





Middle East and sabotage the peace process" and thus, he noted, "it came as no surprise that this Soviet stooge rushed to proclaim its support for the Soviet Union aggression in Afghanistan.

Pointing to the fact that the Arab states, in their support of the Palestinian terrorists, had launched four major wars against Israel with the express purpose of destroying it, Prof. Blum let it be known that "they have developed a ramified series of battlefronts and an array of weapons against Israel, weapons which have involved an economic boycott that has extended into a secondary boycott on third parties trading with Israel," and "various countries have been blackmailed into joining this campaign against Israel."

Prime Minister Menachem Begin's dynamic spokesman here continued in his fiery missile to note that "a propaganda war of major proportions, using the techniques developed by Goebbels and his gang has been directed for years against Israel, and the UN has been seized upon, in all its various organs and agencies as an instrument readily at the disposal of the Arab states, in their relentless political warfare against Israel. This is the reason," he added, "why they have again come to the Secu-

rity Council now."

As for the vicious anti - Israeli "Committee on Palestinian rights, which maneuvered the debate to coincide with the Passover week and with the visits this month of President Sadat and Prime Minister Begin, Prof. Blum reminded the fifteen Council members that this body is not only doing the bidding of the PLO but that it had originally been set up by the Assembly with the view to by - passing Resolution 242. More-over he noted that 19 of its 23 members do not have diplomatic relations with Israel and some do not even recognize Israel's right to exist. "It is thus not surprising," he stated, "that the Committee's recommendations, first set out in 1976 accord with the PLO's aims fully."

In the turmoil that surrounds us in the Middle East and its periphery this is the only peaceful corner from the day we normalized our relations with our southern neighbor. Since then we signed many agreements which stem from the peace treaty. We still have problems, indeed we hope to solve them. We will be faithful to all the terms and all the parts of the Camp David Agreement. There may be difficulties ahead but we started this great new chapter in our life, peace. We live by the faith that in generations to come, our people will live in this land, together with their neighbors in equality, in human dignity, in freedom, in independence and in real security.

Blum Blasts UN

UNITED NATIONS'(WUP) -- "The PLO had become the linchpin of the 'terrorist international' which is plaguing society throughout the world today and which serves and supplies the needs of other terrorist groups in Europe, Latin America. Asia and Africa, all of which train openly on PLO bases."

Trus Yehuda Z. Blum, Israel's valiant spokesman here, charged in a lengthy address delivered before the Security Council which was convened last week at the initiation of the biased "Palestine Committee" notorious for its anti - Israeli stance and which, "as everyone krows, is a pliant tool in the hands of the PLO."


Ambassador Blum made it clear to the Council that the PLO, "in all its criminal activities, is aided, trained and equipped by the Soviet Union" which, in turn, "uses the PLO in its - well - known attempts to destabilize the entire

Having presented this picture baring the true nature and intention of the PLO, Ambassador Blum had no alternative but to say that "here at the United Nations there is a virtual conspiracy of silence about the link which the Arabs have asserted between their oil and the question of the Palestinian Arabs. Here in this Organization a series of myths has been propagated flying in the face of history and presentday political realities. Among these " he noted, "are the following: 1. That the Palestinian Arabs have no state; 2. That only one refugee problem was created in 1948, and 3. That there is some mystical connection between the question of the Palestinian Arabs and the energy crisis, and that the latter will somehow go away if the former is solved at Israel's expense."

He then put forth what he termed "the simple and incontrovertable facts:

"1. Two States have been established on the territory which was the Palestine Mandate be-

tween the two World Wars, one is an Arab State - Jordan, the other is a Jewish State -Israel. 2. The Palestinian Arabs have long in addition to the Arab refugee problem, was
