SADAT SENDS PERSONAL MESSENGER TO ISRAEL

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Egyptian President Anwar Sadat sent a personal messenger to the Israeli Embassy with greetings on Israel's 32nd Independence Day. The messenger, Nassar A-Nassari, met briefly with Israeli Ambassador Eliahu Ben - Elissar.

The Embassy hosted a reception for 250 guests later in the day. Earlier, Ben - Elissar and some 70 other worshippers attended a memorial prayer service for Israel's war dead at the Cairo Synagogue.

In Israel Memorial Day events began with a ceremony at the Western Wall attended by President Yitzhak Navon and Chief of Staff Gen. Raphael Eytan. At 11 a.m. sirens sounded throughout the country, bringing traffic and work to a two - minute halt in memory of the war

ISRAEL MOVES ARMY INTO LEBANON

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israel sent military units into south Lebanon to patrol the border areas in what a military spokesman said was a preven-

tive action to forestall terrorist incursions into Israel. The move came two days after a terrorist attack on Kibbutz Misgav Am, along the Lebanon border, resulted in the death of three Israelis, including a two - and - a - half - year - old boy, and the injuring of 16 others. All five terrorists were killed.

The Israeli move was first announced by the United Nations headquarters in Lebanon. The UN claimed that Israel had brought in 300-350 troops, 19 tanks and 15 personnel carriers.

At the UN in New York Israeli Ambassador Yehuda Blum said the terrorists raided Misgav Am after going through the area controlled by the UN Interim Forces in Lebanon (UNIFIL).
