While the Israeli government has acted responsibly in the wake of the terrorist attack in Hebron which left six dead and 16 wounded, Jewish hot heads on the West Bank have continued their efforts aimed at worsening relations between

Jews and Arabs.

Premier Menachem Begin has stressed that a considered and balanced policy must be maintained in the West Bank to allow for coexistence with the Arabs and to enable the autonomy talks to reach a successful conclusion. The Knesset, in adopting a resolution condemning the terrorist attack in Hebron, called for the restoration of

law and order in the territories to ensure peaceful co-existence between Jews and Arabs.

This has been the policy of Israeli governments, whether Labor of Likud, since 1967. In fact, Israel has proudly pointed to conditions on the West Bank as proof that Jews and Arabs can live peacefully together.

But for the last several years a small group of Jewish extremists have sought specifically to undermine this coexistence. This is especially true of the Kach movement led by Rabbi Meir Kahane, of Jewish Defense League fame, whose admitted aim is to drive out all Arabs from Israel and the West Bank. Their irresponsible actions helps the Palestine Liberation Organization and provide Arab extremists with excuses to engage in their own disruptive tactics.
