The American Jewish Congress filed a friend - of - the - court brief in support of the Stein sisters' suit. The National Council of Churches in Christ joined in the brief.

The Virginia Supreme Court refused to issue an injunction against the Saturday graduation, upholding a ruling by the Circuit of Fairfax Court County.

the decision to the United States Supreme Court.

In its brief, the American Jewish Congress argued:

"Because attendance at commencement is a privilege and a benefit which the school bestows on those who have earned it, in the absence of compelreasons the ling school cannot condition its enjoyment on the relinquishment of the First Amendment's guarantee of the right to the free exercise of religion."
