

War Between Jews

American Jews are constantly being admonished not to interfere in Israel's internal disputes. Yet we should not sit quietly in the face of the growing bitterness between the various factions in Israel. The name-calling has gotten so bad that a group of Knesset members from all parties have gotten together in an effort to end the vituperation that has marked recent Knesset debates.

But even more ominous is the threat of violence between the various sides within Israel. The outrageous Palestine Liberation Organization terrorist attack in Hebron May 2 in which six yeshiva student's were murdered has increased the demand by some Jewish militants for retaliation against the Arabs. This may have been the motive behind the equally heinous attack against West Bank mayors which left two of them maimed. No one yet knows who were the perpetrators of the attack on the mayors but several hitherto unknown ultra - nationalist Jewish groups have claimed credit for the attacks.

One of these groups, calling itself "Terror Against Terror' also claimed responsibility for vandalizing the offices of the leftwing Sheli faction. Some MKs have reportedly been threatened. In return, Shelo has announced it is setting up an unarmed militia to protect its members and property. The situation could eventually turn into one with every faction having gangs, armed or unarmed, whoch could lead to physical fights between the groups.

It was to prevent this that David Ben Gurion at the very outset of the establishment of the State of Israel disbanded the popular Palmach and other separate fighting units. He molded the Palmach, the Irgun, the Stern Group and others into the Israel Defense Force which has become an effective modern army and has helped maintain the democratic character of


Ben - Gurion's old adversary, Menachem Begin, supported him in this. At one time in the 1970, some young members of Herut reportedly wanted to organize to attack leftwing groups. Begin squashed this move immediately.

USSRExploits Olympics

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- All indications point to the fact that the Soviet Union is going to use the 1980 Olympics as a political platform



whereby to split NATO and draw into its orbit many hitherto wavering states.

Despite President Carter's call for a boycom to date some ninty states from around the globe have announced plans to participate in the Olympics, while only twenty - nine of the fiftyone who have announced their non-participation have so far declined an invitation.

While the Soviets, as is known, have exploited this world organization using it as a fertile field in which to win new friends, mainly in the third world bloc, by professing to play the role of benefactor on behalf of all oppressed people, they will be on home grounds in Moscow this summer and no UN forum can give them what an Olympics can provide in the realm of propaganda.

No wonder President Carter, realizing fully well what the 1980 international games will mean for the USSR politically -- especially in the aftermath of Afghanistan and Iran -- is deeply involved in his efforts to win over some of the wavering allies and others to his anti-Moscow-Olympics boycott campaign.

despite the Soviet invasion of Afghanistan, a Moslem state, many Islamic nations including the Arab regimes of Iraq, Libya, Algeria, Jordan, Syria, Kuwait and Lebanon, are among those listed to attend the Olympics. Moscow's price, of course, is a commitment to stand by them versus Israel.

Moreover, nothwithstanding Carter's campaign, such 'allies' as Britain, Austria, Australia, Denmark, Finland, France, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Sweden, Switzerland and Greece plan to go to Moscow this summer. Two other states vital to America's interests, Spain and Portugal, are also sending their athletes to the Russian capital.

Only two Arab states have declined invitations. These are Saudi Arabia and Tunisia. Three others have not yet responded -- Egypt, Morocco and the Sudan. Israel, as was expected, has announced its firm stand with the U.S.

Among the major American allies who have heeded Carter's call are Canada, Japan and West Germany only. There's still a big question about the latter. In the light of Chancellor Helmut Schmidt's projected visit to the USSR later this month, one cannot be too sure about Bonn's intentions. It may well be tempted to follow in the footsteps of France's Giscard d'Estaing, footsteps leading straight into the Soviet orbit and thence into a deal with the Arab

As recently as May 21 -- a few days after the French President had met secretly with Brezhnev in Warsaw to the dismay of Washington -- d'Estaing issued a statement at the Sixth Franco - African Conference which was captioned "France's Position on the European-African-Arab Trilogue." This statement, released by the French Mission here at the UN. was so drafted that one would think that there was no Israel in the Mediterranean world. SHE GETS THE JAGUAR HE GETS THE LIT
