

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A gang of terrorists, attempting to infiltrate Israel by drifting across the border in a balloon, failed in their attempt when the balloon came down near the village of Tibnin in south Lebanon. Chief of Staff Gen. Rafael Eitan said that Israel had advanced knowledge of the attempt. He said Israel had information that the balloon was destroyed near the village and that the bodies of the dead terrorists were taken away before United Nations Interim Forces in Lebanon (UNIFIL) personnel, who saw the crash, arrived at the scene.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Efforts are being made to establish contact with a hitherto unknown tribe of Jews living in a remote region of North Yemen close to the Saudi Arabian border. Mordechai Ben Porat, a former MK who heads the World Organization of Jews from Arab Countries, said the tribe was discovered only recently and is believed to number about 2000 people. Ben Porat said that up to now it was believed only a few hundred Jews lived in that isolated part of the Arabian peninsula, mainly gold and silver-smiths, artisans and weavers.

PARIS (WNS) -- King Hussein of Jordan said here he approved of France - Iraqi nuclear cooperation. "It is extraordinary that Israel, which has failed to sign the nonproliferation treaty, should complain against Iraq which is a signatory of the Vienna Convention" for the international control and supervision of nuclear reactors.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin returned to his desk after being out for four weeks following a mild heart attack.

LOS ANGELES (WNS) -- Ten athletes and sportscaster Mel Allen were inducted into the Jewish Sports Hall of Fame at a dinner attended by 400 persons here. They are Al Rosen, Isaac Berger, Lillian Copeland, Barney Dreyfuss, Marshall Goldberg, Eddie Gottlieb, Harry Litwack, and Gretel Berger, who received a special commemorative. She had been one of the greatest Jewish athletes in Nazi Germany and was denied a chance to participate in the 1936 Berlin Olympics. The Jewish Sports Hall of Fame is a project of the United States Committee Sports for Israel.

PARIS (WNS) -- France officially announced it plans to go ahead with uranium deliveries to Iraq despite claims that Baghdad is in the process of manufacturing atomic weapons. The French Foreign Ministry said that France was surprised by "fanciful statements and accusations" linked to its cooperation with Iraq in the nuclear field.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Independent presidential candidate John Anderson has condemned the United Nations General Assembly resolution against Israel as "designed to undermine American diplomacy and the Egyptian - Israel peace treaty. The resolution will not promote peace," Anderson said he was "disturbed that only six nations joined the United States in voting against this resolution" demanding Israeli withdrawal from occupied territories.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Justice Minister Shmuel Katz resigned from the Cabinet explaining that he did so because his party, the Democratic Movement, has only three members in the Knesset. He acted after MK Akiva Noff left the DM joining two previous defectors, Shlomo Eliahu and Shafiq Assaad in an independent faction. The DM still has two Cabinet members, Deputy Premier Yigael Yadin and Minister of Social Betterment, Yisrael Katz, who is not an MK.
