

U.S. VOTES AGAINST UN "PLAN OF ACTION"

COPENHAGEN (WNS) -- The United States, Canada, Israel and Australia voted against an 186-point "plan of action" adopted at the conclusion of the World Conference of the United Nations Decade for Women because it included a paragraph listing Zionism as one of the world's main evils, along with colonialism and apartheid.

There were 22 abstentions, mostly by Western European countries from the document which was approved by 94 countries.

BEGIN WANTS ELECTIONS IN 10 MONTHS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- It now appears likely that an election for the Knesset will be held next

spring and not in October 1981 when the government of Premier Menachem Begin must call an election. "There is no need to wait for the elections until October," Begin told the Cabinet. "We can hold them in 10 months."

Begin's remarks were made when Energy Minister Yitzhak Modai proposed a raise in electricity rates following the recent increases in the prices of oil. "One cannot raise prices every week," Begin declared. "This is the last year before the elections." Begin's remarks were echoed by Deputy Premier Simcha Ehrlich, a leader of the Liberal Party wing of Likud, who said he will propose to the Likud Executive that early elections be scheduled.

Meanwhile, Begin not only has to find a new Justice Minister but still must find a Defense Minister. He has been acting Defense Minister since Ezer Weizman resigned.

SABBATH OBSERVER GETS \$40,000 IN DAMAGES

NEW YORK (WNS) -- A federal district court in Chicago has awarded \$40,000 in back pay and damages to a Sabbath observer who could not take an examination for a civil service job because it was given on a Saturday.

Howard Zuckerman, president of the National Jewish Commission on Law and Public Affairs (COLPA) said this was the largest amount ever awarded in a case of job discrimination for a Sabbath observer and the first time damages had been awarded based on what someone would have been earning if he had received the job rather than a Sabbath observer dismissed after having the job already.

The case involved Herbert Minkus who could not take a November, 1974, civil service examination for a maintenance la-

borer's job in a Metropolitan Sanitary District of greater Chicago because it was scheduled on a Saturday. Federal District Court Judge Frank McGarr, who was ordered to rehear the case after he had

dismissed Minkus' suit, awarded the \$40,000 as an "equitable estimate" based on the chance that

Minkus would have passed the examination and the chance he might not, as well as other factors.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Despite growing unemployment in Israel, there has been a shortage of manpower for the construction of the new airfields in the Negev, according to Deputy Defense Minister Mordechai Zipori. He said this is why workers are needed from abroad.
