

HADASSAH LEADER SAYS ANTI-SEMITISM ON INCREASE

LOS ANGELES (WNS) -- "Anti-Semitism is on the increase, disguised as anti-Zionism and anti-Israelism, in the various international political fronts operating as bodies of the United Nations," Bernice Tannenbaum, outgoing president of Hadassah declared here.

She told the 3000 delegates to Hadassah's 66th annual convention that Secretary of State Edmund Muskie should have vetoed the recent Security Council resolution censuring Israel for its Jerusalem law instead of abstaining. "Not only does the absten-

tion diminish the meaning of the Secretary's own message, in which he calls the resolution 'fundamentally flawed...unbalanced and unrealistic' and damaging to prospects for peace in the Middle East, but it undermines the U.S. role in promoting the Camp David agreements."

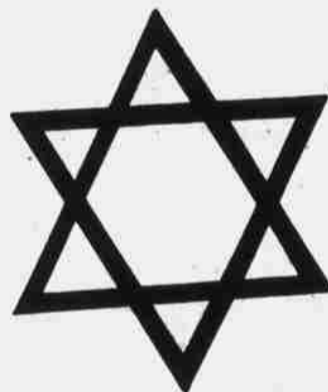

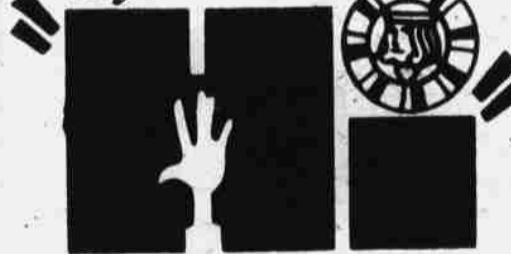
