### JEWISH LEADERS BLAME FRENCH SUPPORT OF PLO

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Former Israeli Foreign Minister Abba Eban said that there was a "psychological link" with French support of the Palestine Liberation Organization and the neo-Nazi upsurge which culminated with the Oct. 3 bombing of a Paris synagogue.

Speaking at the opening "Dialogue 80" session at Congregation B'nai Jeshurun here, Eban said: "If the French government gives such support to the PLO, allows it to have an office, sponsors resolutions in its favor, stresses its place in negotiations, isn't an atmosphere created in which an organization dedicated to violence outside France creates an epidemic inside France?"

A similar view was expressed to a meeting of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations by Howard Squadron, chairman of the Conference, and Rabbi Alexander Schindler, president of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations. Squadron spoke of the meeting he had earlier with the French Ambassador to the U.S., Francois de la Boulez, and Schindler reported on his brief visit to Paris to speak at the bombed out synagogue on the Rue Copernic.

Squadron said that the French Ambassador did not accept the contention that there is a link between

his government's Middle East policy, including its advocacy of full status as a Middle East negotiating party to the Palestine Liberation Organization and the outbreak of anti-Semitism in France.

"I have not seen any sign that the French government will reconsider its Middle East policy which is to appease and give respectability to the PLO," Squadron said, "to join prominently in every public criticism of Israel no matter how extravagant and unjustified; to risk global catastrophe by providing nuclear know-how to the radical regime in Baghdad in exchange for Iraqi oil; and generally to sabotage the Camp David peace process." He said he told the French envoy that the attitude of the Jewish community in America and Americans generally toward France "is going to be tainted" as a result of the French government's pro-Arab policy.

### An Important Lesson

Jews should learn an important lesson from the recent experience in Evanston, Illinois; when the community is united, Nazis run.

This is what happened in Evanston when 5000 people gathered at Northwestern University in a counter-demonstration to a rally being held by American Nazis at nearby Lovelace Park. The Nazis stayed only for five minutes when they found a hostile crowd of some 2000 persons.

American Nazis have fled from other announced rallies in recent years when they found community hostility. Now in the wake of the upsurge of Nazism as demonstrated by the bombing of a Paris synagogue Oct. 3 in which

four persons were killed, it is essential to show this community support both here and in Europe and elsewhere where the Nazis and others spout their ugly brand of anti-Semitism and racial hatred.

The United States Holocaust Memorial Council, whose chairman is the writer and Holocaust survivor, Elie Wiesel, has recently called for all citizens to speak out against this revival of anti-Semitism. It urges rallies, meetings and other appropriate forums to express indignation and condemnation.
