Democratic Rep. Clement Zablocki of Wisconsin and Republican Rep. William Broomfield of Michigan were re-elected and are expected to continue as chairman and ranking majority member respectively of the House Foreign Affairs Committee.

In the Senate, however, the defeat of Church left in the air the future chairmanship of the Foreign

Relations Committee and the chairmanship of its Middle East Subcommittee held by Sen. Richard Stone (D. Fla.) who was defeated in the Democratic primaries.

The defeats of Church, Stone and Sen. Jacob Javits, the New York Republican who was rejected in his party's primaries and ran on the Liberal Party ticket, deprived the Foreign Relations Committee of its three leading supporters of U.S. assistance for Israel.

LONDON (WNS) -- Vanessa Redgrave, the actress who supports the Palestine Liberation Organization, has reiterated her call for Israel's demise to make room for a secular state in Palestine. "I don't think that there is any room for a state of Israel," she said in an interview in the Beirut weekly magazine, Monday Morning. She said that her role as a concentration camp inmate in the recent CBS-TV film, "Playing for Time", "has strengthened my belief that the only way the Jews of the world can press ahead is to struggle with the Palestinian people for the establishment of a democratic, secular state in Palestine."

JOHANNESBURG (WNS) -- The South African Jewish Board of Deputies is demanding an investigation by Pretoria University officials of a "Nazi Victory Party" held on the campus there in September and has sharply criticized the university for failing to denounce the event.

## ISRAEL LOSES LEADING SUPPORTERS

WASH. (WNS) -- Some of Israel's leading supporters in Congress went down to defeat in the wake of Ronald Reagan's stunning victory over President Carter. Republicans gain control of the Senate for the first time in 26 years while the Democrats

retain hold on the House but by a smaller margin.

Frank Church (D. Idaho), campaigning for his fifth term in the Senate, lost to Republican Congressman Steven Symms and with it the chairmanship of the Senate Foreign
