Three Jewish organizations in Las Vegas have joined together with the University Center for Religion and Life to make it possible to employ, for the first time in the history of the community, a Director of Jewish Student Activities who will be available almost on a full - time basis. Jeffrey Bernstein of Minneapolis was selected to fill this position after a search that reached out to over half a dozen communities across the country.

Bernstein, a graduate of the University of Minnesota, has had considerable experience with B'nai B'rith, Hillel and Federations. He attended the Ramah Pro-

grams in Israel, and was a teacher of Sabbath Skills Programs for Beth El Synagogue. Bernstein has been an advisor for USY, a counselor at several camps and has provided private Bar/Bat Mitzvah tutoring.

His honors include: 1975, represented the University of Minnesota Hillel Foundation at the NETWORK National Student Convention; 1974 represented the University of Minnesota Hillel Foundation at Hillel Summer Leadership Institute; 1973, represented USY at leadership Training Institute.

Bernstein will be working with all the sponsoring organizations to develop successful Hillel and BBYO programs. He is the beneficiary of a remarkable volunteer unit in BBYO under the direction of Mort Kirsch, of strong support from B'nai B'rith, and on-going assistance by the Federation and Federation volunteers, particularly Barbara Eisenberg who has worked with the Center and with Hillel to keep the program going until a new Director was hired.

In the spirit of ecumenism by the Center and the mutual support of the three Jewish organizations, there is hope that this approach to solving common problems will benefit an important segment of Jewish youth in the Las Vegas community.



SUPPORT WOMEN RABBIS

KIAMESHA LAKE, N.Y. (WNS) -- The Women's League for Conservative Judaism has come out in favor of the ordination of women as rabbis in the Conservative movement. "The Womens League for Conservative Judaism supports the proposal that women be accepted at rabbinical school students at the Jewish Theological Seminary culminating in ordination," the 2000 delegates to the group's national convention here said in a resolution which was overwhelmingly approved.

Before the vote, Dr. Gerson Cohen, chancellor of the Jewish Theological Seminary, who is in favor of women in the rabbinate, said that "the ordination of women in the Conservative and modern Orthodox movements is only a matter of time. But he said "a frontal attack will only split the community."
