

**ATTENTION: LAS VEGAS HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

This year, Las Vegas High School students will have an opportunity to participate in the People - To - People High School Ambassador Program established by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1956.

According to Teacher - Leader Darrell Woofter, high school juniors and seniors will travel to Washington, D.C., England, the Netherlands, Denmark and Germany for 28 days "acting as ambassadors from the United States."

Student participants are carefully screened and must qualify -- not just financially, but with an interest in international understanding and a sincere desire to be an "ambassador." Extra care

in choosing candidates is necessary as they will live with host families and counterpart students for approximately 15 days in an effort to promote wider and warmer understanding between the diverse cultures, ideologies, and people. Homestays are scheduled for three, four or even five continuous days in various countries and have proved to be the most vital experience of the trip.

At the close of school in June, the selected ambassadors will converge on Washington, D.C. for briefings and orientation by U.S.

State Department officials and by representatives of the Educational Travel Institute.

They will tour the city and have an opportunity to meet and talk with various Senators, Congressmen and other government officials.

The program, supported by Clark County School District administrators, nurtures an increased desire to learn, an enrichment of mind and spirit and a greater understanding of others -- all necessary for the realization of the long range goal of World Peace Through World Contact as envisioned by President Eisenhower.

**MRS. SADAT STRESSES PEACE**

CAIRO (WNS) -- Mrs. Jihan Sadat, wife of President Anwar Sadat, said here that the Egyptian - Israeli peace process would benefit all Arab countries. "Instead of concentrating their efforts in wars, which bring only death and destruction, all Arab countries should concentrate their efforts on peace," she

told a delegation of 54 women on a Canadian Hadassah - WIZO people - to - people leadership mission.

"What we, as humans, can benefit from peace is of great importance to us and to our children. Every one of us wishes to live in peace." Mrs. Sadat, who hosted

the women at her home, stressed the role of women in fulfilling humanitarian aims. She said the status of women in Egypt had improved. Mrs. Miriam Small, president of Hadassah-WIZO, described her organization's work in Israel.
