

ISRAEL WITHDRAWS RESOLUTION

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- Blaming the lack of response from Arab countries, Israel withdrew a resolution it had introduced a week earlier for the "denuclearization of the Middle East." Israeli Ambassador Arie Eilan told the General Assembly's Political and Security Committee that Israel was withdrawing the resolution "with great regret" and warned that "those who have rejected Israel's offer in this committee must bear a very heavy responsibility in the eyes of mankind."

He said there was an "adamant refusal on the part of so many Arab states to respond to Israel's call for denuclearization of the Middle East." The Israeli resolution had called for a conference of Middle East countries aimed at reaching an agreement on nuclear non-proliferation in the region. Eilan accused Iraq and Libya of seeking to introduce nuclear weapons into the Mideast.

"The whole world knows that Iraq and Libya are making enormous efforts to acquire the nuclear option for the price of

oil," he said. "Do the rulers of those countries ever realize that the particles that make up a nuclear fallout know not the difference between Jew and Arab, between Moslems and Christians?"

WEST EUROPEANS ARE WARNED

BONN (WNS) -- Israeli Foreign Minister Yitzhak Shamir urged West Europeans not to do anything that would harm the peace pro-

spects in the Middle East. The Egyptian-Israeli peace agreement is an island of stability in a violent Mideast and deserves the support of all nations, he said at a State dinner given him by West German Foreign Minister Hans-Dietrich Genscher as part of the Israeli Minister's two-day official visit here.

"We cannot agree to decisions or plans that are worked out without being discussed with us," Shamir said in an apparent reference to the European Economic Community's declaration in Venice last June

urging that the Palestine Liberation Organization be included in Mideast peace talks. "Israel is unable to accept participation of a murder organization in peace talks," Shamir said.

Before leaving West Germany, Shamir told a press conference he hopes West Germany will take steps against the increased cooperation between the neo-Nazi movement in the country

and the PLO. Shamir, who met with President Karl Carstens, Chancellor Helmut Schmitz and Genscher, said his talks here had been

"friendly and cordial" Bonn's support of the EEC's Venice declaration. But there were differences such as
