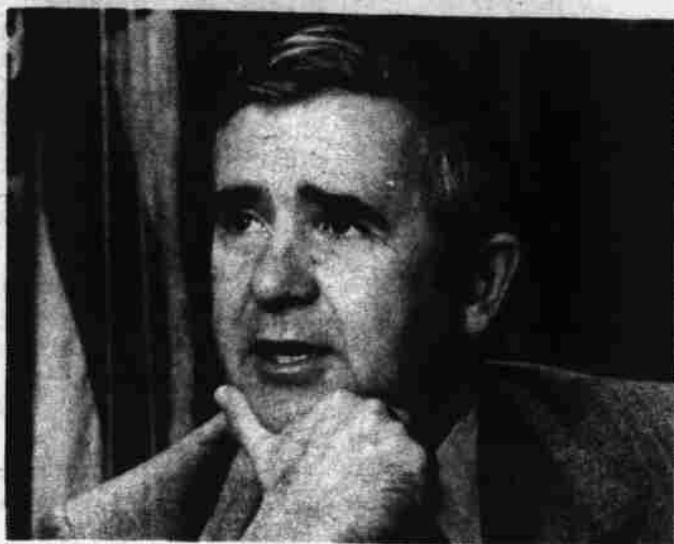


LAXALT TO RECEIVE ISRAEL PEACE MEDAL



SENATOR PAUL LAXALT WILL RECEIVE ISRAEL'S PEACE MEDAL AT STATE OF ISRAEL BONDS ANNUAL DINNER AT ALADDIN HOTEL DECEMBER 7TH.

Israel's Ambassador to the United States, the Honorable Ephraim Evron, will present Israel's Peace Medal to United States Senator Paul Laxalt on Sunday, December 7, Hank Greenspan and Jerome D. Mack, cochairmen for the Bonds for Israel Campaign, announced.

Laxalt, who presided as National Campaign Chairman for president-elect Ronald Reagan, will be presented this special award at the State of Israel Bonds annual dinner at the Aladdin Hotel.

The Israeli Ambassador was born in Haifa, Israel, in 1921. He studied at the Hebrew University in Government Law classes in Jerusalem. During World War II, he served in the British Army between 1941 - 1946. He participated in Israel's War of Independence in Jerusalem in 1948.

He joined Israel's Foreign Service in 1949 and was Political Secretary to Foreign Minister Moshe Sharett. He subsequently served as Chief of Bureau for Prime Minister David Ben-Gurion and in 1953 was appointed to Secretary at the Embassy of Israel in Washington, D.C.

He has held many important positions in the Israeli Foreign Service, having served as Ambassador to Sweden and Ambassador to Canada.

Between 1973 and 1977, he served as Deputy Director General of the Foreign Ministry and subsequently as Director General.

In January, 1979, he assumed his duties as Ambassador of Israel in Washington, D.C.

BEGIN ASKS AMERICAN JEWS TO START NEW LIFE

NEW YORK -- Israeli Prime Minister Menachem Begin has called on American Jews to "come by the thousands and thousands" to help settle and develop all parts of Israel.

Speaking recently before an overflow crowd of 700 American Jews of whom 621 are planning to make Aliyah within the next two years, Begin praised the group enthusiastically.

"The greatness of your Aliyah," the Prime Minister said, "is its idealism."

Usually people leave their country of birth for Israel because they have lost rights or they hope to increase their standards of living," he said, "but no material gains can be expected from this Aliyah. You are not being pogrammed. You are not leaving out of fear. Your syna-
