Jabotinsky's last Will in which he had requested that a Jewish Government, whenever established, bring him home to the Moledet. He and his loving wife repose in peace on one of the most beautiful Jerusalem hilltops. Concluded Prime Minister Begin: On this the 100th anniversary of Zeev Jabotinsky's birth let us turn our hearts to Mount Zion where is interred the man who held aloft Herzl's banner and renewed his national creed. And let us say: Even after your passing, we have continued along the path you set and have invested our every effort to carry out your teachings. And so long as there is life in us we shall persevere into the future, our master and teacher, the bearer of our hope and standard, the immortal Zeev Jabotinsky."

And now, this November 1980, a time, as we stated at the outset, our enemies here at the UN are intensifying their sinister schemes against us, we are witnesses to a real miracle, the miracle of the vindication of truth and justice, the miracle of the hitherto branded 'out-

cast' and the 'rejected' Begin being greeted and accepted with universal acclaim by the Jewish community of the United States.

And this is only the beginning unto final redemption as decreed in our Book of Books.

Fitting Farewell

It was fitting that after Israeli Premier Menachem Begin paid a farewell visit to President Carter at the White House, the two leaders emerged to praise what they had achieved together in the Camp David accords and to urge the continuation of the process. For whatever else can be said about the oft-times rocky relations between Carter and Begin, the Camp David agreements and the subsequent Egyptian-Israeli peace treaty was their finest hour, achievements they share with Egyptian President Anwar Sadat.

Who can forget the joy and surprise that greeted the announcement by Carter, Begin and Sadat that Sunday night when they came down

from Camp David in the Maryland mountains to announce that an agreement had been reached? Or who could forget that sunny March day on the White House lawn when the peace treaty itself was signed?

True, Carter in a way had to be carried into the Camp David process almost kicking and screaming. The Carter Administration came into office wedded to the belief that a comprehensive solution, not piecemeal settlements, was the way to bring peace to the Middle East. It was this and the Administration's attempts to bring the Soviet Union into the Middle East talks, that were partly responsible for Sadat's historic visit to Jerusalem in November, 1977, that began the whole process.

But once Sadat moved toward Jerusalem and was welcomed by Begin, Carter moved every effort to see that the process would succeed. Both Begin and Sadat have credited him with finding the means for an agreement, first for the Camp David accords and then the peace treaty.

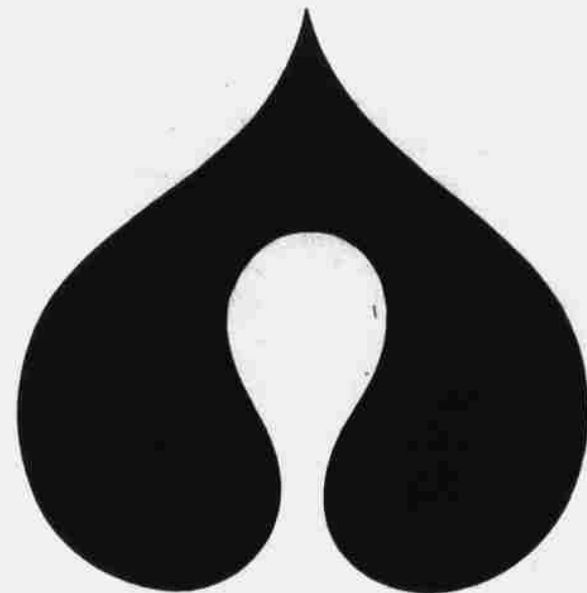
