

**FOUR COMPANIES ACCUSED OF VIOLATING LAWS**

WASH. (WNS) -- Four American companies have been accused by the Commerce Department of violating the Export Administration Act's anti-boycott provisions. The Department said that the MEM Co., manufacturer of men's toiletries in Northvale, N.J. paid a civil fine of \$2000 for two alleged violations. One was for allegedly furnishing information about its business relationships with Israel when it sought to register its English Leather trademark in Saudi Arabia. The other was for allegedly failing to report receipt of a boycott request from an Arab customer. The Air Guide Corporation of Hialeah, Fla., has agreed to pay a civil penalty of \$6000 for allegedly failing to report 12 boycott requests from 1977 through 1979, the Commerce Department said. Nine were from Kuwait and one each from Abu Dhabi, Dubai and Qatar. The Department agreed

to suspend half the penalty and will waive payment of this amount at the end of one year provided that Air Guide neither violates the regulations nor fails to meet any of the conditions set by the Department in the compliance program. LaPine Scientific Company, Inc., of Chicago, has been accused of having failed on four separate occasions between Dec. 31, 1977 and Nov. 21, 1978 to report receipt of requests to engage in restrictive practice. California Farm and Cannery, Inc., of San

Francisco, was charged with receiving eight letters of credit from Saudi Arabian banks which carried instructions as the "invoice must show that goods are not bearing the Israel flag or other symbol signifying Israel."

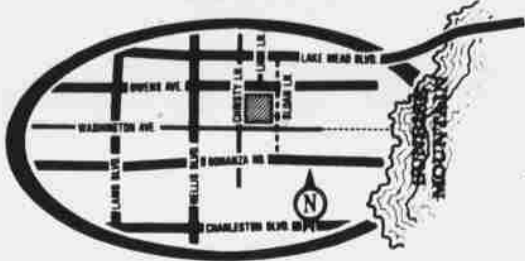
