
JEWS SHOULD HAVE MORE CHILDREN

JERUSALEM (WNS) - Israel President Yitzhak Navon has Jews called on throughout the world to have more children. at the Speaking opening session of the seventh plenary assembly of the World Congress Jewish Navon warned that Jewry was endangered by a low birth rate and assimilation.

Unless there was an increase in the birthrate there would be scarcely 8 million Jews left in the free world by the end of the century, Navon said. He noted that even in Israel the birth rate was down although it was better than the diaspora. He said Israel made up 23 per-cent of world Jewry but 40 percent of it is children. The President also urged the World Jewish Congress to "establish a

dialogue" with Islam. The plenary ses-sion, the WJC's first for six years, brings together some 500 Jewish leaders from 60 countries for a week of deliberations in Jerusalem. Inakeynote address at the opening session, acting President Edgar Bronfman of New York said that Jews influence on government policymaking in Western states was becoming "less ef-fective." In the U.S. he said, while Americans continued to admire and respect Israel as a lone democracy in hostile surroundings the new Reagan Administration "will no doubt strive to maintain Israel's strength and security; but it will probably view Israel as only one important factor in the global East - West struggle."

~HEBREW AND ENGLISH WALL CALENDAR AVAILABLE

NEW YORK CITY, N.Y. -- The Orthodox Union has published a Hebrew and English Wall Calendar, providing a daily sche-dule for the study of classic texts in Talmud and Jewish Law. The Mishna Yomit and Halacha Yomit schedule for the year 5740 is being promoted by the Orthodox Union and its member synagogues throughout North America, as part of the program-ming of its Limud Torah Commission.

According to Julius Berman, President of the Orthodox Union, and Sander Kolitch, Chairman of the Limud Torah Commission, the calendar is dedicated in memory of Rabbi Charles M. Batt, "who dedicated much of his life towards promoting this concept of daily Torah

study by each and every Jew.''

The Wall Calendar provides the Daily Learning Schedule according to the Hebrew calendar for study in sequence, of two units of Mishna (one of the major components of the Talmud) and three paragraphs of Shulchan Aruch (Code of Jewish Law).

The Wall Calendar is part of the overall goal of the Orthodox Union, to encourage Jews in all walks of life to adopt a personal program of daily Jewish Study, in accordance with the precepts of Jewish Law. The Calendar is being distributed to synagogues throughout the country, and is available at a cost of 50¢ each from the Orthodox Union, 116 East 27th Street, Street, New York, N.Y. 10016.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- An Israeli spokesman here said that Israel will cooperate with a three - member military board named by UN Secretary General Kurt Waldheim to investigate charges that Israeli troops mutilated the bodies of five Palestinian terrorists who were killed in south Lebanon Dec. 25. A spokesman for Waldheim said the Secretary General decided to name the board for the sake of "maximum objectivity" in clarifying the controversy between Israel and the UN Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL).
