

HAIG PROMISES TO REVIEW

whether or not we wish in all respects to continue the policy or whether or not in some respects we wish to change it." He said "the study should be expected as normal by any new Administration"

At his press conference, Haig stressed that the Reagan Administration will follow the position of previous Administrations on Jerusalem and the Palestine Liberation Organization. On Jerusalem, Haig said that "for 30 years the U.S. has felt this is a matter that has international implications."

He said the city should "not be divided by barbed wire" or imposed "unilateral restraints." In an apparent reference to the Israeli law declaring united Jerusalem the capital of Israel, Haig said, "We don't welcome unilateral actions that make international consensus impossible."

Haig clarified the U.S. position on the PLO which had been stated only partially by the State Department in the several days before the press conference. "President Reagan has stated, and every American President since 1975 has stated, that we will neither recognize nor negotiate with the PLO as long as they

refuse to accept provisions of United Nations (Security Council) Resolution 242 and other UN resolutions," Haig said. He indicated later he was referring to Security Council Resolution 338.

BRAZILIAN RABBI GIVES POPE MEZUZAH

ROME (WNS) -- A mezuzah made of Jerusalem stone was presented to Pope John Paul II by Rabbi Henry Sobel of Sao Paulo, Brazil, during a 30-minute audience at the Vatican Jan. 24. Sobel said he told the Pope that it was a symbol of "the fraternity of the human race united under God" as well as an affirmation of "the indivisibility of Jerusalem and the Jewish people."

The Pope replied that Jerusalem is "the

city of peace for all religions." Sobel said their discussion had an interreligious dialogue "which did not exclude our differences" but demonstrated the Vatican's commitment "to develop friendship in a spirit of mutual respect and beneficial coexistence." Sobel said the Pope told him the world must learn from the Holocaust that there must be no more victims of persecution, prejudice and hate, Jews and all minorities in general.

The rabbi said a high point of their meeting was an ecumenical prayer of thanks for the release of the 52 American hostages from Iran. "We asked God that these acts of barbarism, terror and fanaticism will never be repeated anywhere in the world," Sobel said.

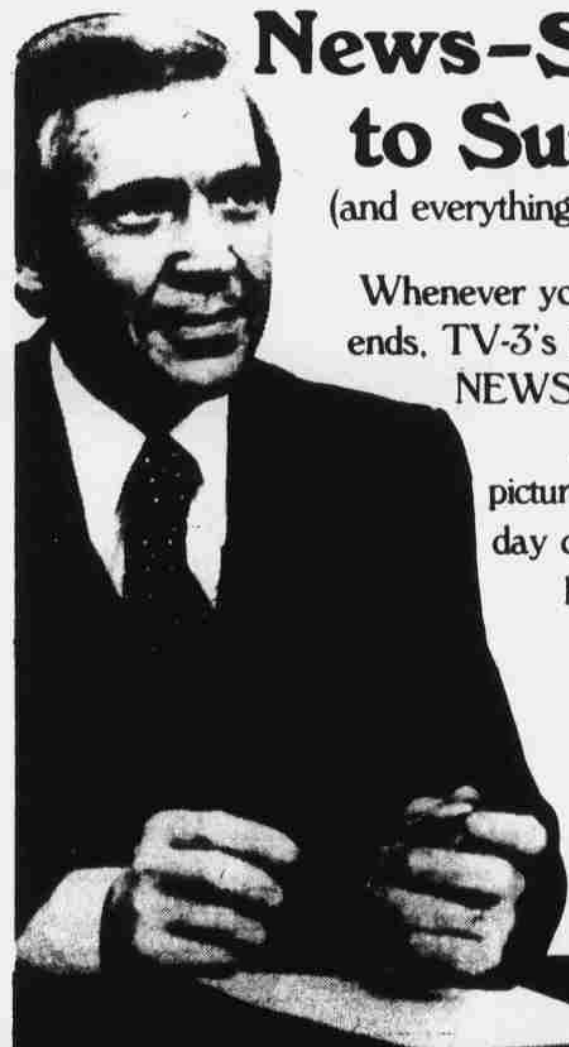
