in their pro - third world approach to the Middle East question and by their apparently deliberate misrepresentation of pro - PLO anti-Israeli resolutions which via an abstention or a 'yes' vote were adopted to the detriment of the Jewish State.

"American failure was total," Moynihan declared. "It was squalid. These men in New York and Washington helped to destroy the President, deeply injured the President's party, hurt the United States and hurt nations that have stood with the United States in seeking something like peace in the Middle East."

It never fails, whenever unified attempts are made by nations in a conspiratorial maneuver against the people of the Book something unexpected happens which frustrates their schemes. In Taif, Saudi Arabia, last week -- at the close of the "Palestine and Jerusalem" summit of the 37 Islamic states, including the PLO, where a jihad was pronounced against Israel -- the President of Lebanon, Elias Sarkis who is a Christian, threw in a bombshell which not only shocked Arafat; it disrupted the summit creating disunion. He bitterly attacked the PLO presence in his country. "Lebanon," he said, "is no longer able to bear the death, destruction and displacement of its people.... We must put an end to the uncoordinated and unilateral actions that harm Lebanon..."

ZIONIST LEADER BLASTS TERRORISM

NEW YORK -- "We join our fellow citizens in expressions of thanksgiving upon the release of Americans held hostage in Iran," said Ivan J. Novick, President, Zionist Organization of America. "The world has witnessed the tyranny of international terrorism as a democratic nation was forced to barter for its own citizens. Those who still advocate appeasement of terrorists are anti - democratic and work against the best interests of freedom loving people

everywhere." Novick concluded his statement by saying, "As we share prayerful appreciation to all who helped to obtain the release of the Americans from Iranian captivity let us re - dedicate ourselves to the fundamental premise, that America with new confidence and self - respect, will resist those who encourage compromise of its basic principles."

MOST JEWS WILL NOT MAKE ALIYA

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- In a blunt speech on Israel - diaspora relations, Edgar Bronfman, of New York the newly-elected president of the World Jewish Congress, declared that most diaspora Jews will not make aliya to Israel and should not be made to feel guilty about not immigrating and that diaspora Jews should not be expected to support Israel blindly on every issue.

The 51 - year - old Canadian industrialist, now a U.S. citizen, made his remarks at the WJC's seventh plenary session at which he was elected president succeeding Philip Klutznick, of Chicago. Bronfman was acting president during the past year while Klutznick served as Secretary of Commerce in President Carter's Cabinet. The new WJC president urged "a new kind of aliya -- investments from the diaspora to help create a more economically viable and attractive Israel."

He told the 500 delegates from 60 countries that the WJC will establish an International Advisory Committee of businessmen, academicians and statesmen

"one of whose first priorities is the furtherance of investment in Israel." Bronfman stressed that "The strengthening of Israel is clearly the first item on our agenda for the coming decades. For all Jews to lead tranquil and meaningful lives, a secure Israel at peace with her neighbors is essential."

But Bronfman stressed that "Israel is not the only item, nor should it be, on the agenda of diaspora Jewry. Jews should be concerned with the affairs, the economics, the moral and political climate of the countries in which they live." Turning to Soviet Jewry, he stressed that "the first priority is to try to get out all the Jews who want to leave, offering Israel as a place where they can come if they so choose. Secondly, for those who want to remain in the Soviet Union we must work to see that they can lead lives as Jews with as much dignity as the confines of the Soviet system will allow."


JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin declared that he was ready to meet with President Reagan or attend a tripartite summit with Reagan and Egyptian President Anwar Sadat despite the Israeli election campaign. "To me the elections won't be an obstacle," Begin said in what observers saw as a deliberate signal to Reagan.
