JERUSALEM (WNS) - Yosef Mendelvich, who arrived in Israel after more than Il years in Soviet prison camps, does not believe Israel does enough to help Jews imprisoned by the government. 'My impression is that Israelis are fantastic in organizing recep-tions when a Prisoner of Zion arrives here. but they take little interest when the prisoner is still langushing in captivity, said in a television interview.

### AGREE ON AID TO ISRAEL BUT ON DEBT

WASH. (WNS) --The Reagan Adminannounced istration it will provide Israel \$2.85 billion in the 1982 fiscal year, the same \$1.4 billion in military aid and \$785 million in economic that has assistance been allocated for the current year. But it has appeared to rule out foregiveness of any part of Israel's \$17.4 billion debt to the United States.

Two-thirds of the \$785 million in economic aid will be a grant. The remaining
