PRESIDENT REAGAN TRIES TO DEFUSE THE LEBANON CRISIS

BEGIN TAKES FIRM STAND

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- President Reagan dispatched veteran diplomat Philip Habib to the Middle East as his special representative in an effort to ease tension that has surrounded the Lebanon situation throughout the month.

Tensions have been raised following the placement of Syrian SAM-6 missiles in Lebanon and Israel's strong hints that it would remove them by military means if other measures did not succeed. Habib departed for Lebanon after meeting with Secretary of State Alexander Haig. Haig called the Lebanon crisis a "delicate and dangerous situation."

State Department spokesman Dean Fischer said that Habib's mission "underscores the importance and urgency that the Administration attaches to defusing the tension in the region." Habib, who is of Lebanese descent and has wide
