FRENCHMAN CHARGED WITH NAZI TIES

PARIS (WNS) -- The French satirical weekly, Le Canard Enchaine, has charged Maurice Papon, Director of the Office of Budget and Management with having collaborated with the Nazis during the German occupation of France in sending Jews to concentration camps and ultimate death, it was reported here.

Papon holds cabinet rank in the government of President Valery Giscard d'Estaing. Papon charged that the left - wing paper is trying to smear him as part of its electoral campaign against the incumbent president who is seeking reelection to a second seven - year term.

The paper charged however, that while Papon served in the office of French Vichy appointed Governor of Bordeaux as the No. 2 man, he willingly helped the Nazis in 1942 and 1943. The magazine cited evidence that Papon was

The magazine pub-lished several official letters requesting police help in conveying the arrested Jews to a transit camp in France where they were due to be handed over to the Germans. The weekly conceded however, that Papon also intervened on behalf of a number of local Jews, women and children totalling about 40 in number. Nazi hunter Serge Klarsfeld said May 6 that letters and memo-

signed by Papon during the war years are on file at the Jewish Docu-Center. mentation which would confirm the magazine's allegations.

"THINK TANK" LEADER CALLED FASCIST

ANGELES -LOS the Institute for Historical Review, a rightwing "think tank" disseminating what it calls "scholarly evidence" that the Holocaust was a Jewish myth, has been identified as a former British neo - Fascist who edited anti-Semitic and racist publication in England before becoming a resident alien in the U.S. in 1978 it was reported.

The Board of Deputies of British Jews identified Brandon as William David McCalden, a former member of British neo - Fascist National Front. The Board of Deputies which represents the Jewish community in the United Kingdom, prodocumentary vided evidence of McCalden's identity and activities to the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith at that agency's request, according to Russell Chandler, Religious Writer of the Los Angeles Times, Howpresent ever, the of Mcwhereabouts Calden, alias Bran-

according to Chandler. He apparently left the state following a lawsuit against the Institute by a Holocaust survivor provided evidence that he saw his mother and two sisters taken to the gas chambers at Auschwitz in 1944. The Institute offered a cash "prize" to anyone who could prove that at least one Jew was put to death in the gas chambers during World War II.

Material provided by the Board of Deputies of British Jews showed that McCalden was born in Belfast and was a writer and editor of anti-Semitic and white supremacist tracts. He defected from the National Front in 1975 to help form the National Party which espouses "British racial nationalism. He He is married to a U.S. citizen. It is not known when McCalden came to California and became associated with the Institute where he was paid \$22,000 a year. The Institute is directly associated with the right anti - Semitic and racist Liberty Lobby, a Washington based are unknown, pressure group.
