

THOUSANDS GATHER FOR 38TH FETE

NEW YORK (WNS) -- An estimated 10,000 people gathered at Temple Emanu-El, inside the sanctuary and outside on Fifth Avenue, in a somber ceremony marking Yom Ha'Shoah and the 38th anniversary of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising. Speaker after speaker warned that there is a resurgence of anti-Semitism around the world, assailed the revisionist historians who claim that the Holocaust is a hoax, and pointed out the dif-

ferences between the 1930's when there was no Jewish state and the 1980's when the State of Israel exists.

President Reagan sent a message to the gathering and said that the historic uprising in the Warsaw Ghetto will be an inspiration to freedom loving people forever.

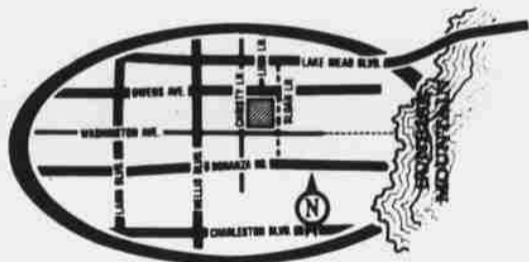

CABINET TOLD NO DEPLOYMENT OF MISSILES

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- According to State-owned Kol Israel Radio, the Cabinet was told that there has been no new deployment of anti-aircraft missiles in Lebanon and that reports to that effect may have been put out by the Syrians as a form of psychological pressure in the continuing crisis.

Premier Menachem Begin, on leaving the meeting, was asked if any progress has been made by U.S. official envoy Philip Habib in his efforts to defuse the situation. He only had a terse reply of "no comment." Habib arrived in Israel May 11 following his visit to Damascus.

Officials in Israel have expressed little optimism over Habib's mission and Israel has indicated it reserves the right to take whatever action it sees fit, including military means to remove the SAM-6 missiles from the Beka Valley in Eastern Lebanon. Before a recent Cabinet session Begin's office issued a statement denying a report published in a Washington Middle East newsletter that the U.S. has given Is-

rael a "green light" to attack the missile installations. The statement issued by Begin said they don't need a "green light" from anyone to make decisions and implement them. Israel thereby kept alive the threat of force to destroy the missile sites. Foreign Minister

Yitzhak Shamir said in a radio interview that it was difficult to envision a peaceful outcome to the crisis and blamed Syrian intransigence. Shamir observed that time available for negotiations was limited but declined to set a deadline for the success of Habib's mission. He again stressed Israel's obligation to help the Christian forces in Lebanon but refused

FRIDAY, MAY 22, 1981 to say whether that help was confined to the Christian enclave along Israel's border or extended into other areas where fighting between Syrians and Christians has occurred.
