NEW YORK (WNS) --An estimated 10,000 people gathered at Temple Emanu-El, inside the sanctuary and outside on Fifth Avenue, in a somber ceremony marking Yom Ha'Shoah and the 38th anniversary of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising. Speaker after speaker warned that there is a resurgence of anti - Semitism around the world, assailed the revisionist historians who claim that the Holocaust is a hoax, and pointed out the dif-

ferences between the 1930's when there was no Jewish state and the 1980's when the State of Israel exists.

President Reagan sent a message to the gathering and said that the historic uprising in the Warsaw Ghetto will be an inspiration to freedom loving people forever.


