BEGIN SAYS SOVIETS INVOLVED IN GROWING LEBANON CONFLICT

SYRIANS HAVE 3000 TANKS, USSR ADVISORS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- United States special envoy Philip Habib returned to the United States after efforts to diffuse the Syrian missile crisis.

However, as the crisis appeared to be in a moment of calm, Premier Menachem Begin charged that Soviet military advisors were accompanying Syrian military units into Lebanon.

Begin's surprise comments asserting for the first time direct Soviet involvement in Lebanon were contained in a speech to a convention of Israeli building contractors in Tel Aviv. "The Syrian have 3,000 tanks," Begin said, "concentrated with Soviet advisors who go together with Syrian units in Lebanon."

Begin did not specifically say that there were Soviet advisors in Lebanon now. But an aide to the Prime Minister is reported to have said later that "wherever big units of the Syrian army go, with tanks and heavy artillery, there are Soviet advisors with them."

Balking at Reality

Jean Kirkpatrick, the United States Ambassador to the United Nations, who formulated the unique view that America must oppose "totalitarian" regimes but be tolerant of "authoritarian" regimes seems to have some difficulty in dealing with political reality.

The politically conservative envoy, who sees red whenever the Soviet Union is mentioned, became color blind when she was asked if she would characterize Argentina as a country which today most resembles that of Nazi Germany. Rep. Clarence Long (D. Md.), chairman of the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Foreign operations, asked that question of Kirkpatrick as she was testifying on the Administration's request for funding to the UN.

The envoy noted that the USSR, Vietnam, and Cambodia under Pol Pot followed many of the principles of Hitler's regime. When Long said he was referring specifically to the anti-Semitic policies of Argentina, Kirkpatrick replied: "I would not be willing to characterize Argentina as uniquely anti-Semitic in our time."

But Argentina, which along with other countries such as Chile, Peru and Paraguay, became a haven for Nazi war criminals after the war, has a long and documented history of anti-Semitism. One of those who has testified to its existence is Jacobo Timerman, the former editor and publisher of the Argentine daily, La Opinion, who was imprisoned, without charges, and suffered degradation, torture and dehumanization at the hands of his jailors for being a Jew and a Zionist.

Timerman recounts the vicious anti-Semitism rampant in Argentina in his book, "Prisoner Without a Name Cell Without A Number." He points out that while Jews comprise
