Sen Cannon's Message


"When I met recently with a group of Jewish leaders from Las Vegas I stressed my opposition to the proposed sale of AWACs to Saudi Arabia. I am against this both because of its effect on the delicate balance of power in the Middle East and because of what the Iranian revolution taught us about the safety of our advanced military equipment.

Simply put, I would not like to see the Saudis gain a strategic advantage through possession of AWACs, nor would I want to see these aircraft in unfriendly hands if something unexpected happened in Saudi Arabia.

AWACs is one of the most sophisticated command and control systems in the entire U.S. military inventory. It is extremely important in our relationship with NATO and NATO's responsibility concerning Eastern Europe. We must protect AWACs from any possibility of falling into enemy hands.

I reiterated this position recently at the 22nd annual policy conference of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee meeting in Washington."

This week, Secret Witness will pay up to \$1,000 cash reward for information leading to the arrest and indictment of the person or persons who committed Grand Larceny at the Vegas Wash Marina on Lake Mead.

On Sunday, May 24, 1981, a trailer with two jet skis, which were chained to a motor home were stolen. The chain was cut. Brand of trailer Carrier SPCNS with California License NT 6829, Serial Number CAL 166752. The jet skis were both Kawasaki, Number 1, 1976, California CA 3378FZ, Hull KAW 051920676, No. 2, 1976, California CA 3379 FZ, Hull KAW 058350776. The jet skis are yellow top. Bottoms are yellow with orange tint. The batteries were out of the jet skis being charged at the time of the theft.

Anyone having information pertaining to the theft of the trailer and skis is asked to call Sgt. Paul Fava, Lake Mead National Recreation Area at 293 - 4041, or the Secret Witness Hot Line at 386 - 3213. Callers do not have to reveal their identities in giving information or to collect the cash reward. Secret Witness will also pay cash rewards on other major crimes or crimes that are being planned.

If anyone has information on major crimes at any of the other marinas or on Lake Mead they will be paid cash rewards by Secret Witness.
