BEGIN'S MILITARY MOVE HAS RESOUNDING EFFECT


TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The Israeli government announced June 8 that Israeli air force planes attacked and completely destroyed the Iraqi nuclear reactor nearing completion near Baghdad

In an exceptional announcement during the Shevout holiday, the Government said the action had been ordered as it has learned from the "most authoritative and credible sources" that the reactor was intended, despite Iraqi denials, to produce nuclear bombs, the announcement said that the Iraqi president had himself announced after the reactor had been slightly damaged by the Iranians a year ago that the weapons it would produce would be used only against Israel and the Iranians therefore had nothing to fear.

All Israeli planes returned safely to base after their raid which was the longest carried out by the Israeli aircraft apart from the Entebbe rescue operation.

The government announcement said that the bombs to be produced by the "Osiriak" reactor near Baghdad would be made from enriched uranium and plutonium, the type used at Hiro-

Begin's Gutsy Move

(EDITOR'S NOTE: The Israeli Government has been severely criticized for its precise bombing of the Iraqi nuclear reactor plant. The LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE supports Prime Minister Begin's gursy move 100 per cent. Why would Iraq need a nuclear electrical plant? No oil rich nation does! Israel must protect itself from fanatical governments who would use a nuclear bomb to wipe out the Jewish Nation without batting an eye. The real culprit is the French Government for supplying Iraq with the technology to build such a plant. Long Live Prime Minister Begin and the strength of the Israeli Army. The following is a recreation of the incident, D.T.)

TEL AVIV, Israel -- The long hot Sunday was drawing to a close as a fleet of camouflage painted Israeli warplanes took off from their base and wheeled eastward over the desert expanses of the northern Arabian peninsula. It was 4:45 p.m., June 7,

Laden with 2,000 - pound bombs, their fueltanks brimming, they set out on a 600 - mile flight to attack a nuclear reactor on the banks of the Tigris River in Iraq.

Less than an hour later the bombers moved in over their target. In three minutes the reactor lay in ruins and the jets were turned toward home.

As the planes headed out on their mission, Prime Minister Menachem Begin invited his ministers to his house in Jerusalem. Elsewhere in Israel, in a secret warroom, the country's top generals begin their vigil. Radio contact with the planes was broken. There was little idle chatter in the war - room where I t. Gen Raphael Eytan, military chief of staff, and Maj, Gen. David Ivri, the air force commander. presided.

Few Israelis knew the mission was underway. Many were camping in the countryside, enjoying a sunny long weekend because of the Jewish harvest holiday of Shavuot.
