BEGIN IS VICTORIOUS; CLAIMS "ABSOLUTE MAJORITY" IN KNESSET

BEGIN WILL FORM NEW GOVERNMENT

JERUSALEM (WNS)
-- At the first
assembly of the Cabinet since the June
30 elections, Prime
Minister Menachem
Begin said that, there
is "no doubt whatever" that he would
be called upon by President Yitzhak Navon
to form a new government. Begin also read
out to the ministers
the final -- though still
unofficial -- vote results

Tabulated minutes before the Cabinet session by the Central Election Committee at the Knesset, they gave Likud 48 seats, Labor 47, National Religious Party 6, Hadash (Rakah Communists) 4 Agudat Israel 4, Tami 3 Tehiya 3, Telem

(headed by Moshe Dayan) 2, Shinui 2, and Citizens Rights Movement (headed by Shulamit Aloni) l. The offi-cial results will not be announced until all seamen's votes are counted. But there is too small a number to make a difference in the outcome, Mean-while soldiers' ballots gave Likud a sharp edge over Labor. With about half of the soldiers' vote tallied, Likud led Labor by 43 to 36 percent, far better than it did with the general public. Begin said that by

PREMIER SAYS ONE

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin appearing on the ABC-TV "Issues and Answers" program declared that he will form the next Israeli government based on an "absolute majority" in the Knesset, probably in partnership with three religious parties. Begin said the vote count which gave Likud 48 Knesset seats to Labor's 47 indicated that "we are the largest group. By all the rules of democracy we expect to be invited by the President next week to form a government."

Begin shunned suggestions that he might have a problem governing with such slim margin. He said one vote is a majority, "an absolute majority." Begin declined to say if he had any firm commitments from potential coalition partners. He indicated however that he was almost certain to reach agreement with the National Religious Party, the ultra - orthodox Agudat Israel and the new sephardic religious party Tami, which will have 13 mandates between them. Such a coalition led by Likud would command a bare majority of 61 seats in the 120 member parliament.
