

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

LONDON (WNS) -- Postal authorities here intercepted a letter bomb addressed to Greville Janner, a Labor MP and president of the Board of Deputies of British Jews. Police said the explosives, detected at a post office in Worthing, Sussex, contained in a hand addressed brown envelope, were sufficient to maim the recipient but not kill him. Janner has been a prominent campaigner against neo-Nazi and racist organizations and an outspoken defender of Israel.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The prestigious "Paul Baerwald Award for Education for Social Service" was presented here to Kate and Herbert Katzki for their joint and separate work over more than 40 years in Jewish refugee work. The award was made at commencement exercises at the Baerwald School of Social Work of the Hebrew University. Herbert Katzki retired in 1979 as a senior Joint Distribution Committee Executive. His wife is currently in her second term as chairman of the Non-governmental Organization Committee of UNICEF.

GENEVA (WNS) -- A Dutch woman who helped save many Jews during World War II was awarded the "Medal of the Just" in Bern by the Israeli Ambassador to Switzerland, Mattityahu Adler, it was reported here. Mrs. Charlotte De Habish, who lives in Fribourg, Switzerland, was a young student in Holland when she helped Jews to escape. Wearing a yellow Magen David, the only way she could penetrate into the Jewish ghetto, she took out young Jewish children and helped them cross the border into Belgium where they were hidden on farms.

SAN FRANCISCO (WNS) -- An oral history project to gather the recollections of persons saved from the Holocaust by Raoul Wallenberg has been announced by Joel Brooks, executive

director of the Northern California division of the American Jewish Congress it was reported here. Brooks said that, wherever possible, the project would tape interviews with persons who knew or worked with Wallenberg in 1944 and 1945, and with those whose lives he saved.

BRUSSELS (WNS) -- Jean - Robert Debbault, a rightwing militant who spread propaganda that the Holocaust never occurred was sentenced to two years imprisonment by a Court of Appeals for incitement to racial hatred, it was reported here. The defendant had appealed an 18-month sentence imposed earlier by a lower court. But the appeal was rejected and six months added to the original term.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The National Conference on Soviet Jewry reported July 2 that a total of 866 Jews left the Soviet Union in June, the lowest number for any single month this year except January when 850 departed.
